1/ In FY 2012, the Child Care Entitlement and TANF levels are estimates based on current law. The Child Welfare Study level assumes enactment of the proposed extension of this funding in FY 2012. All other amounts are enacted.

2/ In FY 2010, obligations of \$212,397,000 are available from the original 1997 funding level.

3/ Amounts include FMAP assistance provided in the Recovery Act (P.L. 111-5), available through December 31, 2010. The Education Jobs, and Medicaid Funding bill (P.L. 111-226) extended the enhanced FMAP provision at a phased-down rate through June 30, 2011, providing an estimated \$66.2 million in additional assistance.
