## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 41

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF 2 THE MISSISSIPPI GAMING COMMISSION AND THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF 3 THE JOINT LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE ON PERFORMANCE EVALUATION AND EXPENDITURE REVIEW TO DEVELOP A MAP INDICATING THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA 5 ON THE MISSISSIPPI COAST THAT IS ELIGIBLE FOR LICENSED GAMING 6 UNDER STATE LAW. 7 WHEREAS, determining if a potential licensed gaming location 8 on the Mississippi Coast is within the geographic area allowed 9 under state law currently requires an individual determination 10 upon each request made to the Mississippi Gaming Commission; and 11 WHEREAS, efficiency and transparency would be improved if a map existed to determine eligibility of a proposed licensed gaming 12 13 location on the Mississippi Coast; and WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Mississippi Gaming 14 15 Commission and the Executive Director of the Joint Legislative Committee on Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review are 16 17 best equipped at developing a map that will provide clarity and 18 efficiency in determining if a potential licensed gaming location

on the Mississippi Coast is within the geographic area eligible

under state law; and
