

# Administrative Regulations Notice

## October 2024

---

The Department for Public Health has filed the following administrative regulations:

- **902 KAR 4:150.** Kentucky Lifeline for Moms program implementation. This new administrative regulation establishes the procedures to implement the Kentucky Lifeline for Moms program which will ensure healthcare providers who, upon examination, are concerned that an eligible patient may have a perinatal mood disorder, are able to consult with a mental health professional who can recommend an appropriate course of action.
- **902 KAR 95:041.** Repeal of 902 KAR 95:040. This new administrative regulation repeals 902 KAR 95:040 as 2022 Ky. Acts ch. 73 repealed and reenacted KRS 211.9101 to 211.9135 and moved the administrative oversight of the radon contractor registration program from the Cabinet for Health and Family Services to the Public Protection Cabinet.

Anyone wishing to make a public comment on these administrative regulations may do so in the following manner:

### PUBLIC HEARING AND PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD:

A public hearing on this administrative regulation shall, if requested, be held on **December 23, 2024**, at 9:00 a.m. using the CHFS Office of Legislative and Regulatory Affairs Zoom meeting room. The Zoom invitation will be emailed to each requestor the week prior to the scheduled hearing. Individuals interested in attending this virtual hearing shall notify this agency in writing by **December 16, 2024**, five (5) workdays prior to the hearing, of their intent to attend. If no notification of intent to attend the hearing is received by that date, the hearing may be canceled. This hearing is open to the public. Any person who attends virtually will be given an opportunity to comment on the proposed administrative regulation. A transcript of the public hearing will not be made unless a written request for a transcript is made. If you do not wish to be heard at the public hearing, you may submit written comments on this proposed administrative regulation until **December 31, 2024**. Send written notification of intent to attend the public hearing or written comments on the proposed administrative regulation to the contact person. Pursuant to KRS 13A.280(8), copies of the statement of consideration and, if applicable, the amended after comments version of the administrative regulation shall be made available upon request.
