On July 1, 2002, the legislature enacted laws allowing a driver whose privilege to drive was revoked permanently following a conviction for felony Driving under the Influence (DUI) or Refusal to Submit to Chemical Testing (Refusal) to apply for a termination of revocation. This law only applies to drivers convicted on or after July 1, 2002 under AS 28.35.030 (n) or AS 28.35.032 (p). To be eligible for a termination of revocation you must have served at least 10 years of the revocation period and you have not been convicted of a criminal offense since your license was revoked.

this application if:

1. you were convicted of felony DUI (AS 28.35.030(n)) or Refusal (AS 28.35.032(p)) _____;
2. the court ordered a lifetime revocation;
3. 10 years has passed since your privilege to drive was revoked _____;
4. you have not been convicted of a driving related criminal offense in the 10 years preceding the submission of this application.

this application if:

- your felony offense(s) occurred July 1, 2002;
- you have been convicted of a driving criminal offense within the last 10 years

All sections of this application must be completed and all required documents in Section B must be attached. Applications not meeting submission requirements will not be processed. Once your application is accepted, your criminal record and driving record will be reviewed for eligibility. If your application for termination is approved, you will be notified of your reinstatement requirements.
