TVM Requirements

- Subrecipients receiving funds from FTA for the acquisition of vehicles or ferries intended for paratransit services are required to report purchase information.
- Must report new vehicle purchases within 15 days.
- The reporting requirement aims to ensure transparency and accountability in the utilization of FTA funds for paratransit related vehicle acquisitions.

FTA Goal Methodology

The purpose of the the USDOT Civil Rights Goal Methodology ensures non-discrimination and promotes equal opportunity in transportation programs. It aims to:

- 1. Ensure Compliance with civil rights laws.
- 2. Promote Equal Opportunity for all, regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, or income status.
- 3. Support DBE Participation by setting and monitoring goals for disadvantaged business enterprises.
- 4. Collect and Analyze Data to identify and address disparities.
- 5. Encourage Public Participation in transportation planning.
- 6. Monitor and Enforce Compliance with civil rights requirements.
- 7. Provide Training and Assistance to help recipients meet these requirements.

Overall, it fosters an inclusive and equitable transportation system.
