LAUNCH OF THE AFRICAN SEISMOLOGICAL COMMISSION (AfSC)

Johannesburg, South Africa



The African Seismological Commission (AfSC) was launched on the 22 January 2014 during an Africa-Array workshop held at WITS university in Johannesburg, South Africa.

The meeting was well attended and an attendance register was circulated in order to build a contact database of all interested parties. There were representatives from 21 African countries at the meeting: Algeria, Ethiopia, Madagascar, Ghana, Malawi, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Angola, Egypt, Senegal, Morocco, Libya, Nigeria, Cameroon, DR Congo, Tanzania, Mozambique, South Africa, Cape Verde Republic, Botswana and Rwanda.

The meeting was opened by the IASPEI President, Domenico Giardini, and Secretary General/Treasurer, Peter Suhadolc.

The AfSC interim secretary, Michelle Grobbelaar, continued with a presentation on the formation of the AfSC and what has been achieved so far, eg a review of the statutes, creation of a logo and publicising the commission.

The meeting then addressed each statute individually and the comments and changes were reflected.

The statutes which drew the most attention and discussion were statutes:

2 - Membership; 4 - The Council; 5 - The Executive Committee and 10 - Approval of the Bylaws.

The reason for this discussion was the issue of a lack of IUGG members within Africa. However, this was temporarily addressed in the statute on Membership (2) and will be reassessed in 2018, as indicated on the approval of the Bylaws.

In addition, invitation letters will be sent to the institutions of non-IUGG country representatives to nominate their representative in AfSC and the letter should be signed by the institution heads.

The statutes were then adopted by all present. The executive committee was then elected as follows:

Atalay Ayele (Ethiopia) – President

Bekoa Ateba (Cameroon) – 1st vice president
Ahmed Hosny Ali (Egypt) – 2nd vice president
Michelle Grobbelaar (South Africa) - Secretary
Paulina Amponsah (Ghana) - Member

There was a request to IASPEI to draft a letter naming the elected interim executive committee for use in obtaining support for AfSC.

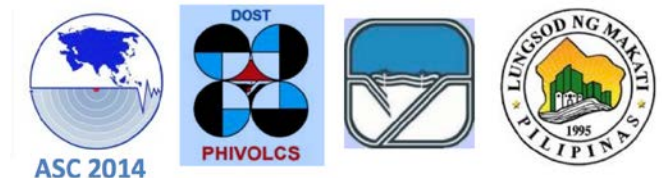
The location of the first assembly was not decided upon, but there were a few ideas to host it in Algeria, Egypt or South Africa in 2016.

**EDUARD SULSTAROVA
(1934-2014)**

Eduard Sulstarova, an Albanian seismologist, passed away on January 15 at Tirana, Albania, after an acute disease at the age of 80. He was born in Korça, Albania and was a graduate of 1963 of University of Tirana.

After a specialization for seismology in China Mr. Sulstarova was engaged in the foundation of the Albanian Seismological Centre and was its head and director for 20 years. In his long career in seismology, Prof. Dr. Sulstarova has collected and studied historical and instrumental earthquakes of the country focusing on their focal mechanism and stress field. He is author and co-author of many scientific papers and books, the last of which is "Seismicity, Seismotectonics and Seismic Hazard Assessment in Albania" (Published by The Academy of Sciences of Albania, Tirana 2010).

After the political system changed in the country, Prof. Dr. Sulstarova was in late 90s a Member of Academy of Sciences of Albania and Secretary General of this Academy.

He was Titular member in the European Seismological Commission (1974-1996), a representative of the government of Albania to the Permanent Committee for Seismic Risk Reduction in Balkan Region (1981-1993), and member of the Steering committee in the project UNDP/OPS Seismic Risk Reduction in the Mediterranean Region (1988-1992).

Survivors include his wife Ikbal, two daughters Alma and Silva and a lot of grandchildren.
