- ** Domestic violence programs provide services to victims of domestic violence that can, but doesn't have to, include emergency shelter. Currently, all of the domestic violence programs funded through SCDSS include emergency shelter. Some programs have more than one shelter site. Other services include, but is not limited to, counseling, legal aid, transportation, and employment assistance.
- *** Reflects the number of unduplicated adults and children served by providers. (Unduplicated=unique individuals)
- **** Residential and Non-Residential Counseling services, including individual and group counseling sessions. The significant decrease in the number this year is due to a change in the federal requirements: they are no longer asking for service contacts but want to know the number of individuals instead. This number is calculated from data submitted by providers per Federal Grant requirements.
