• Identify and enact change in the areas DSS has the power, influence, and responsibility to advance racial equity and eliminate disproportionality.



- Collaborate with provider and community partners to enhance capacity to deliver timely, quality, and robust services to meet the needs of children, youth and families.
- Deepen DSS' commitment to family and equity by enhancing kinship services and supports that build and strengthen the family's capacity to stay together.



- Implement permanency strategies so that children and young people leave the system with a permanent family or a responsible, caring adult in his, her, or their life.
- Build the competencies, skills, knowledge and abilities of our professionals and create a safe and supportive environment to effectively partner with youth, families and community to carry out the values of DSS.
