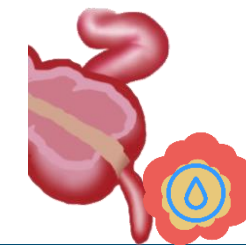




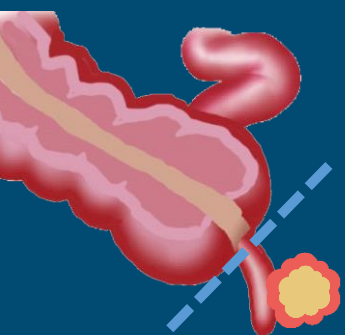
ASCRS Clinical Practice Guidelines: Appendiceal Neoplasms



Colonoscopy should be done with workup (1C)



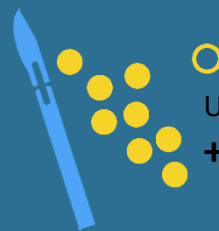
Appendectomy indicated if **abnormal appendix** seen during unrelated operation (1C)



Neuroendocrine:

Right Colectomy

if: >2cm, high grade, LVI, base or mesentery involved (1C)

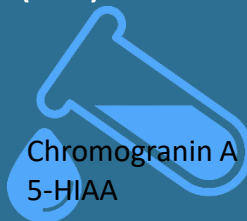


Up to 40% with + Lymph Nodes

Neuro-endocrine specific **imaging** not always required (2B), but **biochemical testing** recommended (2B)



Somatostatin Scintigraphy
Dotatate-PET



Chromogranin A
5-HIAA

Mucinous/AdenoCA:

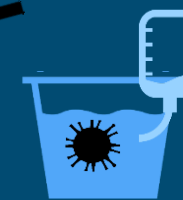
Low Grade **Mucinous**:
Appendectomy alone (1B)



Adenocarcinoma:
Right colectomy (1C)



Peritoneal Involvement:
Cytoreduction ± HIPEC (1B)
