SPOTLIGHT: MEADE COUNTY

POP brings kids to the farmers' market



After the local farmers' market, vendors noted the decreasing percentage of young consumers. They contacted the Meade County Family and Consumer Sciences Extension Agent about the possibility of presenting Power of Produce (POP) during market hours. To support the project, we secured funding in the amount of \$500 from the local Farm Bureau. Extension advertised the program through the local newspaper, radio, and via Facebook posts. The six-week series featured opportunities for young children to earn up to three POP bucks: one for coming to the market, one more if they tasted the Plate It Up! recipe we demonstrated, and a third if they participated in the feature activity of the day. The series was a great success. The farmers' market reported a total of \$647 redeemed and attendance sheets reflecting more than 500 kids participating.
