Step-by-Step Towards HBM Certification

- Attend a Homebased Microprocessor (HBM) workshop. You must pass both tests to successfully complete the training.
- When you receive your workshop certificate, make a photocopy to include in the HBM application packet.
- Get recipes approved for ALL HBM products you plan to process. Each recipe should be submitted for approval to Annhall Norris. There is a \$5.00 fee per recipe. You will be invoiced for payment. Recipes can be submitted online from the UK Homebased Processing and Microprocessing site using the Submit HBM Recipe Online link https://uky.az1.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV 0MJZ6QJbkhL5ZY1 or mailed to the address below:

- When you receive the approved recipes, make a photocopy of each to include in the HBM application packet.
- Make draft labels for each recipe. The labels and corresponding recipes should be included in the HBM application packet.
- Fill out the application for HBM certification. DON'T FORGET TO INCLUDE:
 - Copy of workshop certificate
 - ♦ Copy of each approved recipe
 - ♦ Copy of draft label for each product
 - ♦ \$50.00 certification fee, **check payable to Kentucky State Treasurer**
