



SHARING YOUR FULBRIGHT STORY

Guidelines for Submissions

Do:

- Interact with your colleagues and the local community
- Get verbal consent to take photos with others
 - When submitting, identify the people in the images and let us know you've gotten their permission to submit
- Take photos in natural or even lighting
 - Use flash when necessary
- Showcase your Fulbright merchandise and signs

Don't:

- Don't prioritize taking photos over being in the moment
- Don't submit photos without consent
- Don't submit photos of minors without parental consent
 - Don't show the faces of minors. Take photos where they are not facing the camera
- Don't use filters or overly edit your photos
- Don't use a fisheye or 0.5x lens
- Don't take overly exposed or backlit photos
- Don't submit photos with prominent logos (other than your institution's), alcohol or inappropriate dress
