



# Guide to Buy/Sell Oysters

## Steps to buy/sell oysters from Private or Public Ground:

- 1. You must first become a Certified Shellfish Dealer through Virginia Department of Health/ Division of Shellfish Safety and Waterborne Hazards (VDH/DSSWH)
- Click here for further information about becoming a Certified Shellfish Dealer.
- 2. Contact VDH/DSSWH for information and inspection of establishment.
- Click <u>here</u> for contact information.
- 3. Once you have been inspected and certified through VDH/DSSWH, you will be placed on the Interstate Certified Shellfish Shippers List. The certification expires the end of September of each year.
- Click <u>here</u> for the Interstate Certified Shellfish Shippers List.

#### **VMRC License requirements:**

Once you become a Certified Shellfish Dealer and you wish to buy oysters from <u>Public Ground</u>, you will need:

- MRC ID number (Commercial or Non-Commercial)
- Oyster Buyers User Fee
- Oyster Buyers License
  - Oyster Buyers Place of Business Permit (Gear Code 414)
    - No Fee for permit.
  - Vehicle or vessel ID Permit (Gear Code 414) for each vehicle or vessel that carries oysters.
    - No Fee for permit.
- Purchased at the Main Office ONLY, preferably by appointment.
  - Contact (757) 247-2200 to get in contact with the Licensing Department to make an appointment.

### There are two types of Oyster Buyer User Fees and Oyster Buyers Licenses:

Oyster **Single Buyer** User Fee (Gear Code 385) / Oyster **Single Buyer** license (Gear Code 412): A single place of business with one boat or motor vehicle used for buying oysters.

Oyster **Multiple Buyer** User Fee (Gear Code 386) / Oyster **Multiple Buyer** license (Gear Code 413): A single place of business with multiple boats or motor vehicles used for buying oysters.

#### First time as an Oyster Buyer:

#### Need a Non-Commercial MRC ID Number:
