2.	President's Report	<ul> <li>Board of Trustees will meet next week on Thursday and Friday. The theme is "Many People, One Community." Discussing 21 finance committee resolutions. One, in particular, is on property in Hamburg. 40 acres of continuing property</li> <li>Search updates: EVPHA search committee has been assigned, and a search firm has been chosen. The goal is to have this person start later this summer. 6. Committee Reports	<ul> <li>Consent Agenda passed unanimously</li> <li>Pulled agendas: Bylaws         <ul> <li>Bylaws: C. Harper</li> <li>Their committee was tasked with coming up with language for the term of office for the chair from one fiscal year to two fiscal years</li> <li>All other officers should remain for one fiscal year</li> <li>Term limits: the elected chair will serve only two consecutive terms and must sit out a term to be considered for the Chair's office again</li> <li>A. Strassburg: if the chair has to step down during the cycle, who will step in, and would they be able to serve for another two consecutive terms since they stepped into that role? M. Adams said they could finish out the term</li> <li>J. Sumner: have we looked into term limits for every officer? We will consider this suggestion</li> </ul> </li> </ul>



	<ul> <li>B. Allen: why would the Vice Chair not step in? The Vice-Chair could step in until the election was held to fill the vacancy</li> <li>E. Wilson: is there anything in the bylaws for the Vice Chair stepping in? O. Ellis said yes, there is</li> <li>M. Henderson: what if the officer term limit extends beyond the officer's 3-year term as a representative? For example, if they are elected chair during the 3rd year of their term.</li> <li>C. Larmour: For II.1.3.a.i - I propose we change "The elected Chair" to "A regularly elected Chair" to make it clear that when someone fills a vacancy by special election, that does not count as their first term of a two-term limit</li> <li>C. Larmour: Section 3.2.a - I think within the next two regular meetings might be more practical, or "at the next regular or special meeting at least one week in the future," just to encompass the possibility that a vacancy happens too close to a meeting (I know we can't account for all exceptions, but this seems like it could easily be an issue)</li> <li>A. Walters: Comments from a non-senator colleague: The chair term limit should be up to two consecutive terms. Minor phrasing difference. And what's the logic for the president needing to be absent from that position for two years? It seems excessive, especially when there are no other term limits for different positions</li> </ul>
