

2011 NPDRS RECOMMENDATIONS (from 2011 DALLAS NPDRS minutes):

- Bacterial leaf blight/streak of rice (*Xanthomonas oryzae* all pathovars) -funded
- Cotton leaf curl virus -funded
- Root Knot and Cyst Nematodes- funded
- “Zebra Chip” (*Candidatus Liberibacter solanacearum*) on solanaceous crops -not funded
- Citrus black spot (*Guignardia citricarpa*)- not funded
- Cowpea mild mottle virus - not funded

2011 DALLAS NPDRS

Considered but not recommended

- Chrysanthemum white rust (*Puccinia horiana*)
not funded

2011 DALLAS NPDRS

Recommended for UPDATE of existing recovery plans:

- *Ca. Liberibacter asiaticus* (Huanlongbin; Citrus Greening) -funded
- downy mildews of grasses (to combine *Sclerophthora rayssiae* and *Perenosclerophthora phillipensis* plans) -funded
- *Ralstonia solanacearum* Race 3 biovar2 -funded
- plum pox -funded
- potato wart -funded

CONSIDERATION FOR NEW PLANS

- *Candidatus Liberibacter solanacearum* on solanaceous crops **recommended but not funded 2011**
- Citrus black spot (*Guignardia citricarpa*) - **recommended but not funded 2011**
- Cowpea mild mottle virus - **recommended but not funded 2011**

CONSIDERATION FOR NEW PLANS

- Sweet orange scab (*Elsinoe australis*)- short-listed (– moderate ranking St Louis 07)
- Boxwood blight *Cylindrocladium pseudonaviculatum* (*C. buxicola*)
- Impatiens downy mildew (*Plasmopara obducens*)

- Filling Gaps in Existing Plans
- Pathogen Groups with commonalities in epidemiology, dissemination, control/management
- Merge NPDRS Recovery Plan with APHIS Response Guideline?
