# Ambitious set of potential projects

- Projects listed as possibilities include
  - 1) Updates and extensions to existing satellite or supplemental accounts
  - 2) Development of additional satellite accounts
  - 3) Better incorporation of new and “free” goods into GDP
  - 4) Creation of dashboards of existing measures
  - 5) Production of measures of aggregate economic welfare
  - 6) Creation of data products to support measures of subjective well-being
- More projects than realistically can be accomplished, but there are still others could be added to list
  - Production of more geographically disaggregated data would have high value for many non-governmental users

# Evaluation criteria

- List of evaluation criteria could be shortened
  - 1) Is BEA the best organization to take on the project?
    - Whether project a good fit with BEA's mission and expertise to be weighed in answering this question
  - 2) How relevant and useful is the resulting information likely to be to policymakers?
  - 3) How relevant and useful is the resulting information likely to be to other data users?
  - 4) Is there an acceptable and implementable methodology available to carry out the project (or is it likely that one can be developed)?
- Projects pursued and/or frequency with which products produced will depend on resources
