Thank you for your application for renewal in the Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program. Attached is a new Certificate of Accreditation covering the one-year period beginning January 26, 2025 and a current Scope of Accreditation.

Copper by EPA 200.8_5.4_1994 in Drinking Water has been withdrawn from accreditation at the Laboratory's request.

Based on your laboratory's most recent PT Study results, full accreditation is warranted for all applicable parameters. As a reminder, continued participation in the Ecology Lab Accreditation Program requires the lab to:

- Submit a renewal application and fees annually
- Report significant changes in facility, personnel, analytical methods, equipment, the lab's quality assurance (QA) manual or QA procedures as they occur
- **Participate in proficiency testing studies semi-annually, with the following exception: For each parameter where all PT results were satisfactory for the past accreditation year, you are required to submit only one PT result over this next year, and in subsequent years, as long as the results are satisfactory.**


