FAO Strategic Framework 2022-31

- 43rd FAO Conference endorsed Medium-Term Plan (Reviewed) 2022-25, Programme of Work and Budget 2024-25
- 20 Programme Priority Areas (PPAs) articulate FAO's thematic, technical comparative advantage
- Regional Priorities elaborated within the context of relevant PPAs and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)
- Regional Foresight Exercise implemented to accelerate strategic thinking

Priority areas of work in 2024-25 and beyond

- Four Regional Priorities:
 - ✓ Sustainable agrifood production systems
 - ✓ Efficient and equitable food and nutrition systems
 - ✓ Climate action and sustainable natural resource management
 - ✓ Building resilience, ending poverty
- Aligned with the four betters, 20 PPAs and respective SDG targets
- Brings systems approach to enhance strategic positioning of FAO

Accelerators, cross cutting issues, corporate initiatives

- Continue to focus on accelerators: innovation, technology, data, complements
- Ensure cross-cutting issues gender, youth, inclusion reflected in all FAO's work
- Build on regional dialogues and consultations to support Members
- Scale up corporate initiatives
 - ✓ Revise business model for the Hand-in-Hand Initiative (HiHI)
 - ✓ One Country One Priority Product (OCOP) strengthen areas of complementarity with HiHI and Digital Village Initiative
 - ✓ Expand portfolio in the Digital Village Initiative

- Collaborative work with partners
 - ✓ African Union to support the Post-Malabo Framework

 - ✓ Multi-lateral financial institutions
 - ✓ UN Development System repositioning
