

JAMSTEC is calling for **an expression of interest** for piggyback projects onboard R/V Mirai on her revisit to P01 in 2021 summer.

Please note that under the current pandemic, all aspects of the cruise project are subject to change including last-minute cancellation of the cruise. Please also note this is a very busy cruise and we cannot spare any cruise time to your project. Some sampled water and laboratory space might be available, but not guaranteed.

If all above conditions are acceptable, please submit a short (1 to 2 page) application in any format readable to me (plain text, Microsoft Word, PDF, no hand writing please) as email attachment to the PI (Shinya Kouketsu [skouketsu@jamstec.go.jp](mailto:skouketsu@jamstec.go.jp)). The application needs to list:

1. Name and email address
2. Purpose of observation (1 line is good)
3. Description of method (1 paragraph is good)
4. Required resource onboard (instrument(s) onboard, water quantity, sampling frequency/depths (if known), etc.)
5. Number of personnel onboard from the project

**Deadline: 20th October 2020**

Please note that we cannot guarantee acceptance of all applications. If we have more applications than we can afford, we will prioritize the projects and may have to reject some.
