## **Vaccine Storage**

In response to the high wind event, the Vermont Department of Health has activated it Health Operations Center. The State Emergency Operations Center is also activated. In areas where there is a high wind warning it will last until 8:00 p.m. October 30.

At this time, there are numerous power outages throughout the state. The Public Health Laboratory in Colchester is open and functioning, but is operating on generator power.

## **Vaccine Storage**

Many primary care practices list local Vermont hospitals as a backup location for vaccine storage.

Practices who think they may need to move vaccine must first get approval from the Health Department Immunization Program at 802-863-7240.
