

Application guideline for the “11) SCOSTEP Visiting Scholar (SVS) Program” in FY2023

ISEE is a host institute of the SCOSTEP Visiting Scholar (SVS) program (<https://scostep.org/svs/>). There have been many requests of recommendation letter to ISEE for the SVS program, while ISEE can support only 2–3 visitors for this program. Thus, we have to make a pre-selection in ISEE to write a recommendation letter to SCOSTEP.

- (1) For those who want to stay at ISEE, Nagoya University, Japan, through the SCOSTEP Visiting Scholar (SVS) program, please contact to the potential host researcher in ISEE with your proposal.
- (2) The application should be submitted through the “Joint-Research On-line Integrated System (JROIS)” website (<https://jrois2.isee.nagoya-u.ac.jp>, which is **different from the previous URL**). The application form files can be downloaded from ISEE website. Please refer to the following URL:

- (3) The PI applicant is requested to access the above JROIS website to obtain a login account. After registration on this website, you will receive an e-mail with a password for your account. If you have already had an account in the past, you can use it again this year. After logging in the JROIS website, please visit the application page to enter the program title, corresponding ISEE researcher, the related technical committee (Integrated Studies, Heliospheric and Cosmic-Ray Research, Ionospheric and Magnetospheric Research, Meteorological, Atmospheric and Land-Ocean Ecosystem Research, Chronological Research, or Airplane Usage), and e-mail address of the corresponding ISEE researcher, then **upload** the following 1, 2, and 3 proposal documents **in a Zip file** and submit it by January 15, 2023. The areas grayed out do not need to be filled in.
- (4) The proposal should contain the followings:
 1. Curriculum Vitae
 2. Publication List
 3. Research Plan (maximum 2 pages)

The research plan should contain the following points:

- ① What is the scientific question you want to solve during your stay in ISEE?
- ② What is the strategy to solve that question using what data/model provided by ISEE?
- ③ Why is it necessary to visit ISEE to solve that scientific question?
- ④ What sort of skill do you have for the research, including the computer language you use for data analysis?
- ⑤ Host researcher in ISEE

ISEE will notify the acceptance/rejection of the applications in the second half of January 2023. The successful candidates will obtain recommendation letter from ISEE. The successful candidates need to submit their proposal with the ISEE recommendation letter to SCOSTEP. Then, another selection will be made in SCOSTEP.

Those who stay in ISEE under the SVS program are requested to submit a summary report to the “SCOSTEP Visiting Scholar (SVS) Program” website by **March 31, 2024**. Please write Form11-1 then upload them to the website by March 31, 2024.
