To qualify for performance-based scholarships, students must have a minimum 3.3 GPA and a 26 ACT score. Need-based scholarships are available for students with a lower Student Aid Index (SAI). All scholarship offers are communicated in writing and cannot exceed the direct cost of education at KSU. Students must complete the FAFSA and apply for financial aid each year.
