RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board hold a hearing to determine whether to allow a substitution as requested, pursuant to Los Angeles Administration Code Section 10.14(3)a, inasmuch as a letter of objection, dated July 27, 2006, was received.

SUMMARY:

The Department is in receipt of a request from Los Angeles Engineering, Inc., general contractor for the Taylor Yard Project Phase II – New Park Development (W.O. #E1904346), Contract No. 3165, to substitute the following subcontractor:

Golden State Roofing & Waterproofing (GSRW) with Weather-Tite Roofing to perform the installation of the roofing subcontract work on this project. The request is being made inasmuch as GSRW did not execute a contract with the general contractor for this project.

Pursuant to Section 10.14 of the Los Angeles Administrative Code, the Bureau of Contract Administration, Department of Public Works notified the subcontractor, GSRW, by certified mail (as on file in the Board Office) of the contractor’s intention to substitute them, as GSRW had refused to execute a written contract. This notice was received by GSRW on July 25, 2006, and as the subcontractor has five working days in which to file a written objection to this substitution, they responded on July 27, 2006 with a letter of objection faxed to the Bureau of Contract Administration, attention Mr. Larry Reynosa (as on file in the Board Office).

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In accordance with Section 10.14(3), "If written objections are filed, the awarding authority shall give five days' notice to the prime contractor and to the listed subcontractor of a hearing by the awarding authority on the prime contractor's request for substitution. The determination of the awarding authority shall be final."
