Please accept this letter from the Mid-Atlantic Fishery Management Council (Council) in support of Biodiversity Research Institute (BRI) and the Long Island Commercial Fishing Association in their proposal to the opportunity notice, entitled "Working With Commercial Fishermen and Other Marine Professionals to Determine Offshore Occurrence Patterns of Bats and Landbirds."

While the Council is not involved in the management of bats or landbirds, we are following offshore wind energy development issues closely and believe this project would be an important contribution to the body of knowledge on potential wildlife impacts from these projects.
