



NHC announces new Marine Outreach Page

The Tropical Analysis Forecast Branch (TAFB) of NOAA's National Hurricane Center has a new marine outreach webpage.

The page features key annual outreach events by TAFB, an interactive "request for outreach" form, and resources for mariners, including a portal to access nautical charts and the latest notices.

The marine meteorology section of the outreach page includes a detailed fact sheet on marine weather, tropical marine climatology, tides, current and sea surface temperature information and gridded marine forecasts for 10 meter winds, 10 meter wind gusts, wave heights and warning hazards.

The TAFB generates analyses and forecasts over the tropical and subtropical eastern North and South Pacific and the North Atlantic basins year-round. TAFB products include but are not limited to: High Seas, Offshore Waters, Marine Weather Discussion, Tropical Weather Discussion, and graphical surface and ocean wave analyses and forecasts.

The redesigned web page will be a key component of the NHC/TAFB booth at the 34th International Miami Boat Show, the largest yearly outreach event for TAFB.
