



Transfer of southeast Pacific High Seas Forecast for MetArea XVI to Peru

The Tropical Analysis and Forecast Branch (TAFB) of the National Hurricane Center (NHC) will transfer high seas forecast responsibility for the southeast Pacific Ocean (WMO marine METAREA XVI) to the Directorate of Hydrography and Navigation of the Navy of Peru (DHN) effective Friday, June 30, 2017 at 1800 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC). The high seas forecast area encompasses the southeast Pacific from 3.4S to 18.5S and east of 120W.
