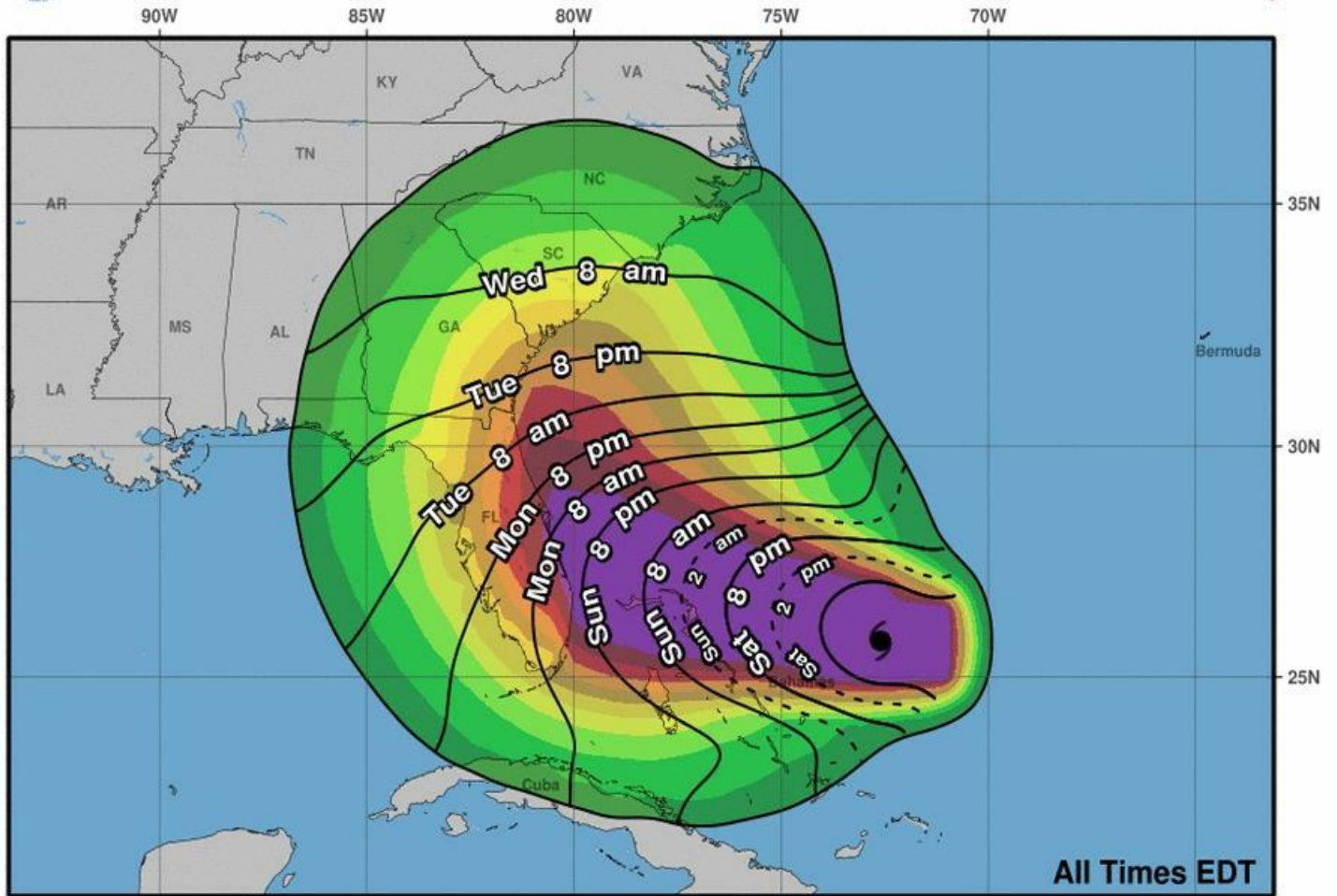
I believe this was the graphic that POTUS was referencing. It shows AL included in a small (5-20%) but non-zero chance to see winds exceeding 39 mph.
