Activity Sheet 10

How Many Places & People Can You Name?

Instructions: This is the opening activity for Module 3, *Pre-Referral and Referral Activities*. Part of that module is going to look at the system called child find. Child find operates in every State. Its purpose is to identify and locate all children with disabilities in the State, to ensure that their unique developmental and educational needs are addressed. That includes our youngest children—infants and toddlers with developmental delays or disabilities.

Work with a partner. Together, list as many places as you can think of where you'd expect to see infants and toddlers. Write these in the left column. Then, in the right column, list the kinds of people you think are likely to be interacting with babies and toddlers and, thus, have the opportunity to notice that a child may have a disability or delay in development. We've started both lists with an example.
