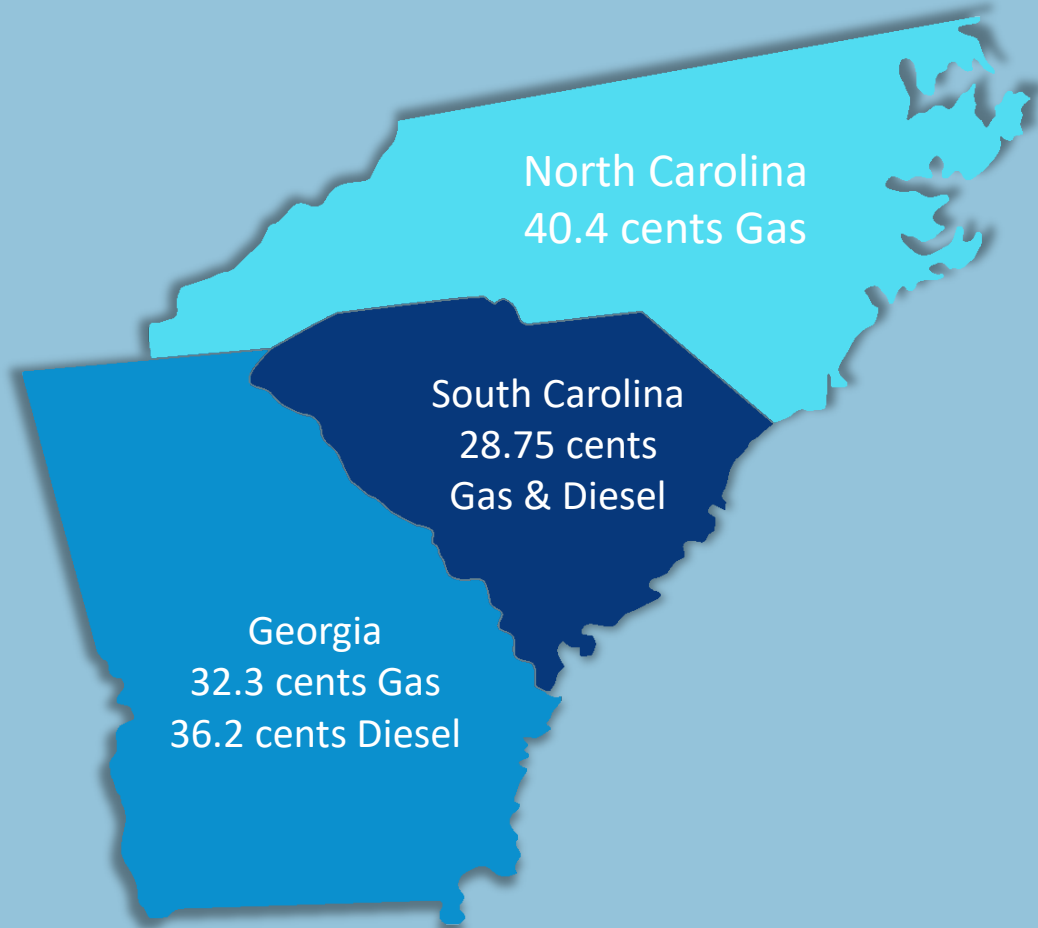


Infrastructure Plays a Major Role in the State's Ongoing Prosperity

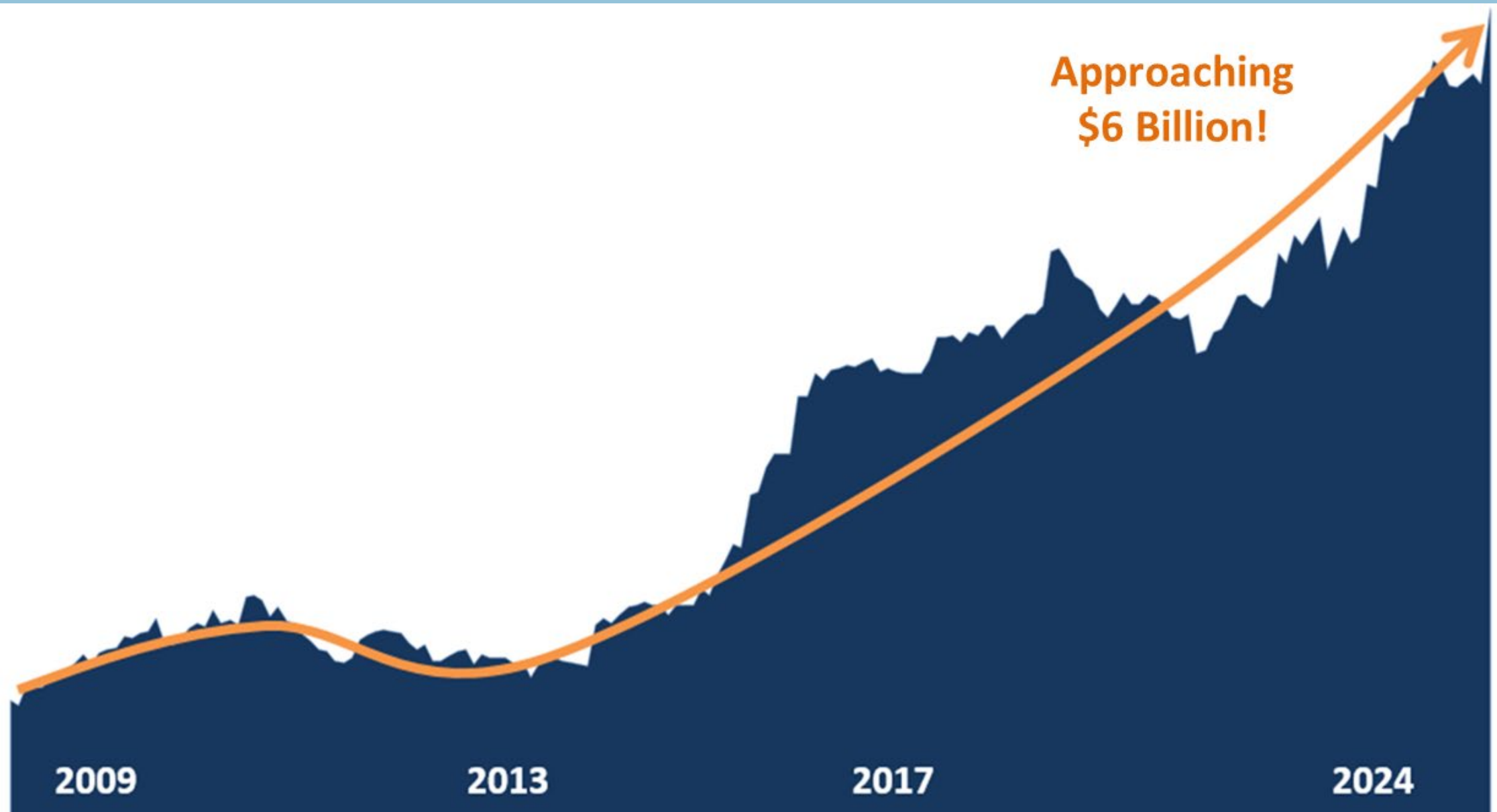
We connect supply chains and must efficiently move people, goods and services throughout our vast infrastructure network.

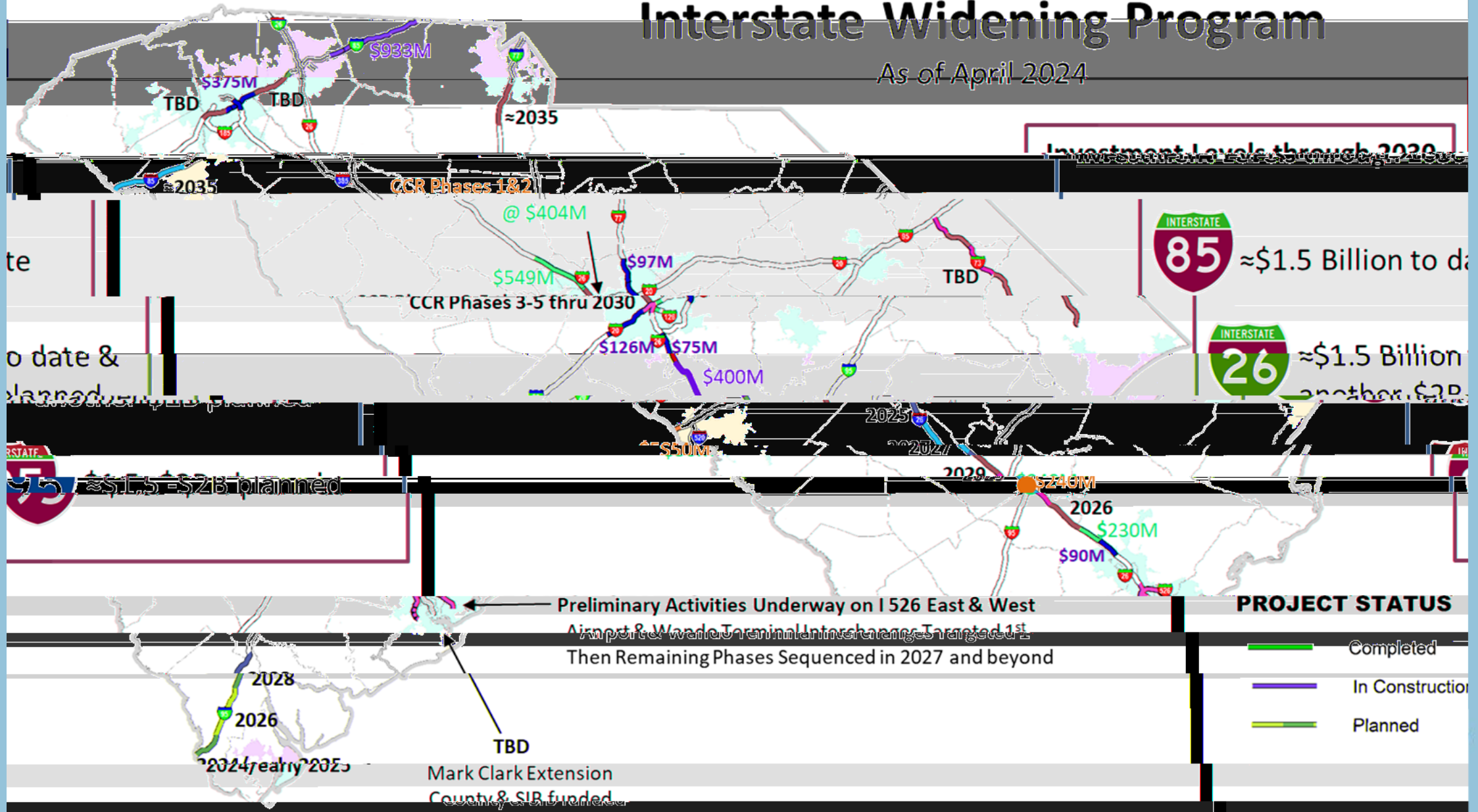

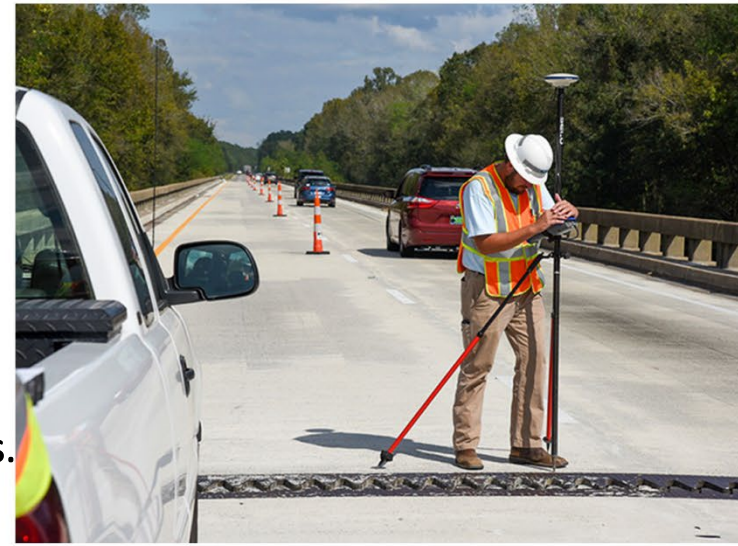

Key Bridge Facts

- Approximately 8,400 bridges owned by SCDOT.
- 10-Year Plan Annual Budget: \$239M
- Bridges are inspected at a minimum every two years with underwater inspections every five years.



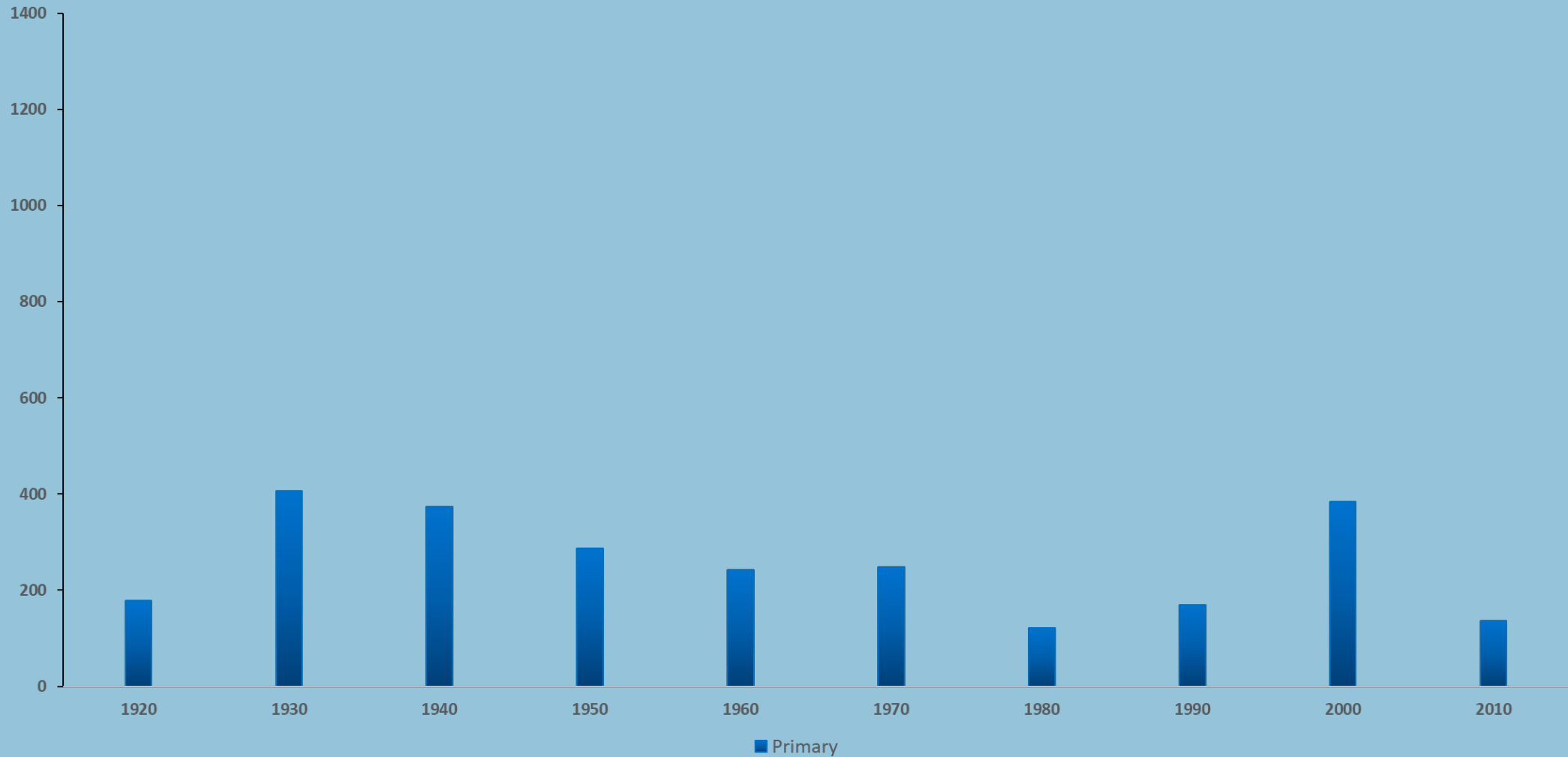

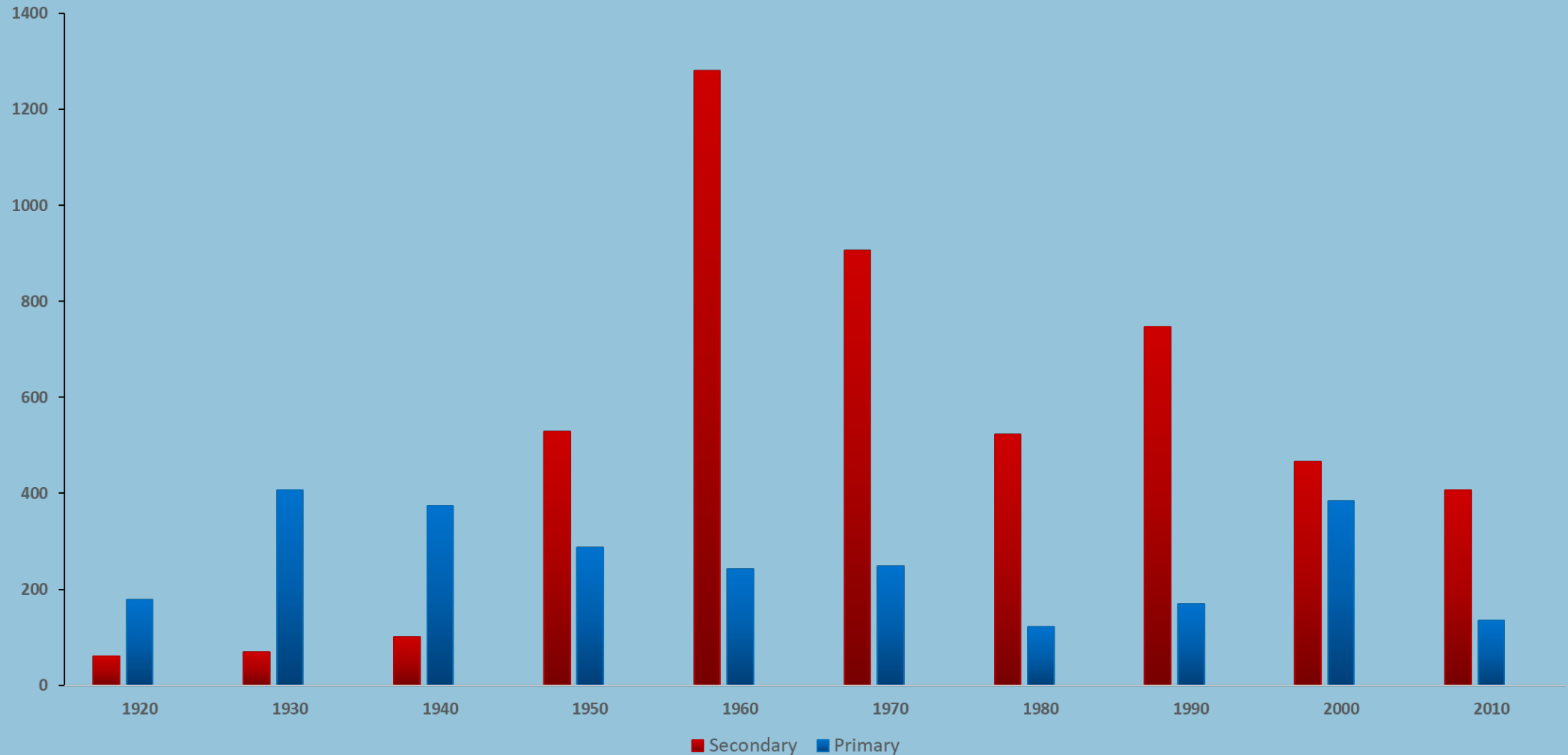

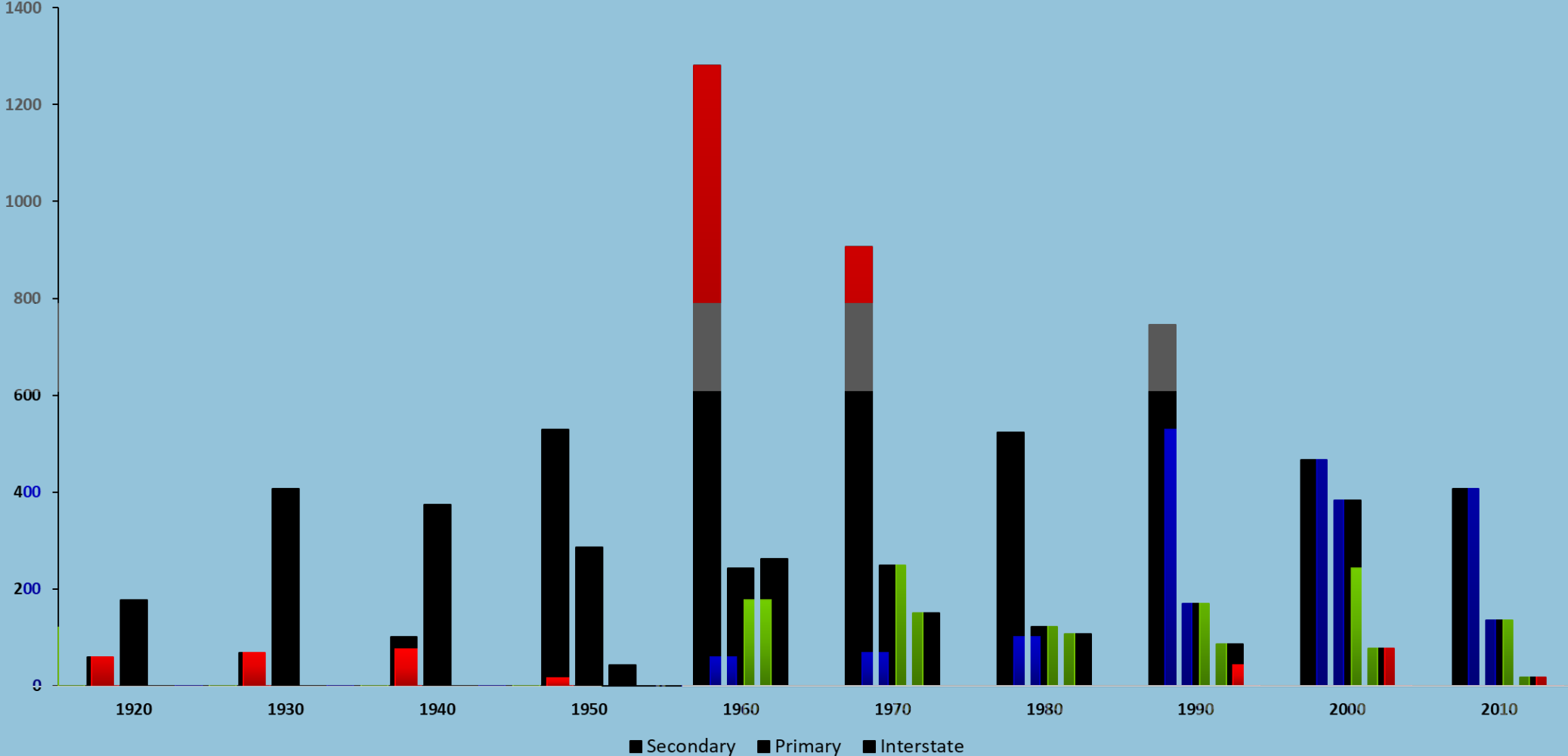
A Looming Bridge Crisis: Primaries



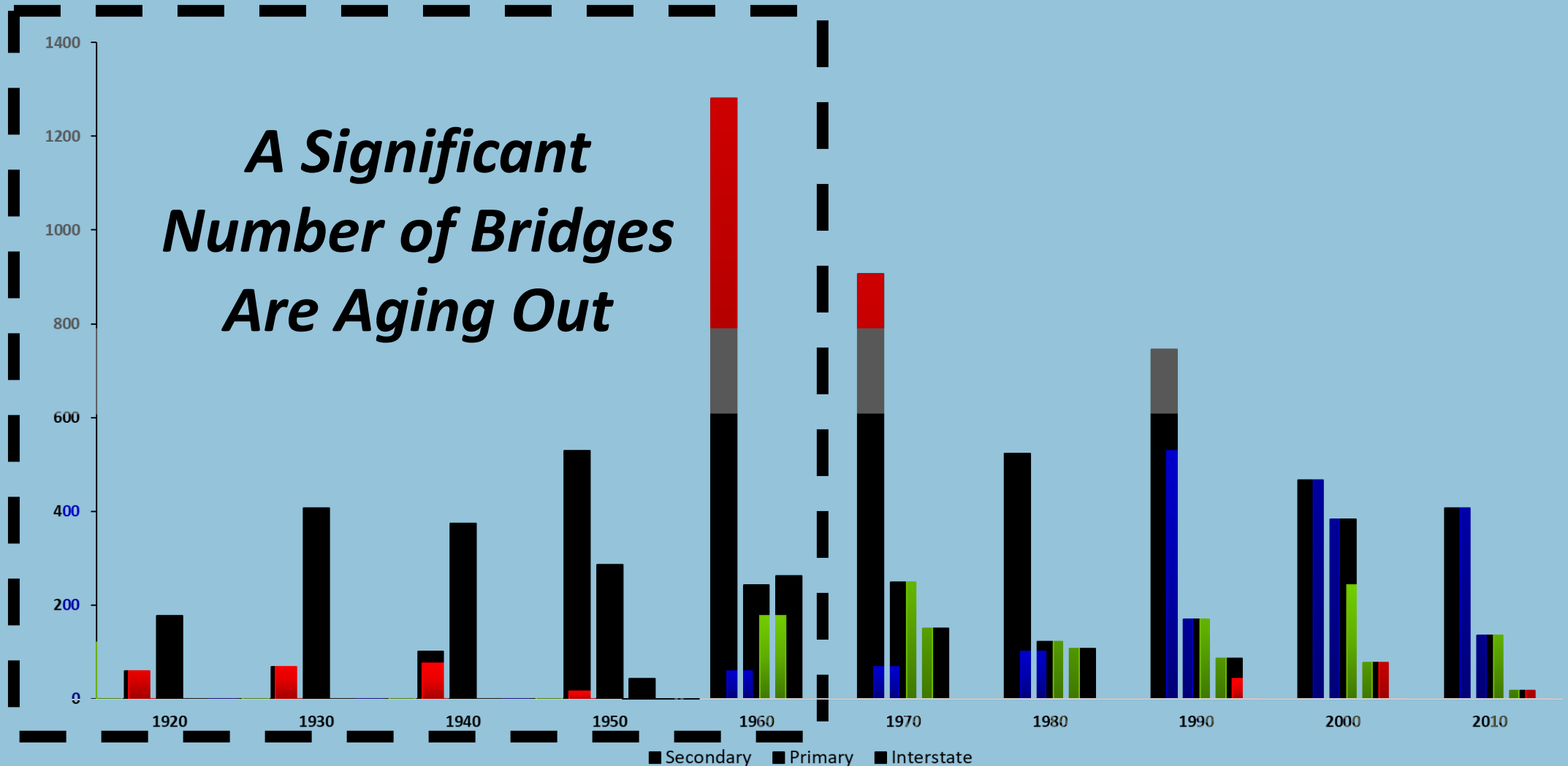
A Looming Bridge Crisis: Farm-to-Market Secondaries



A Looming Bridge Crisis: Interstates

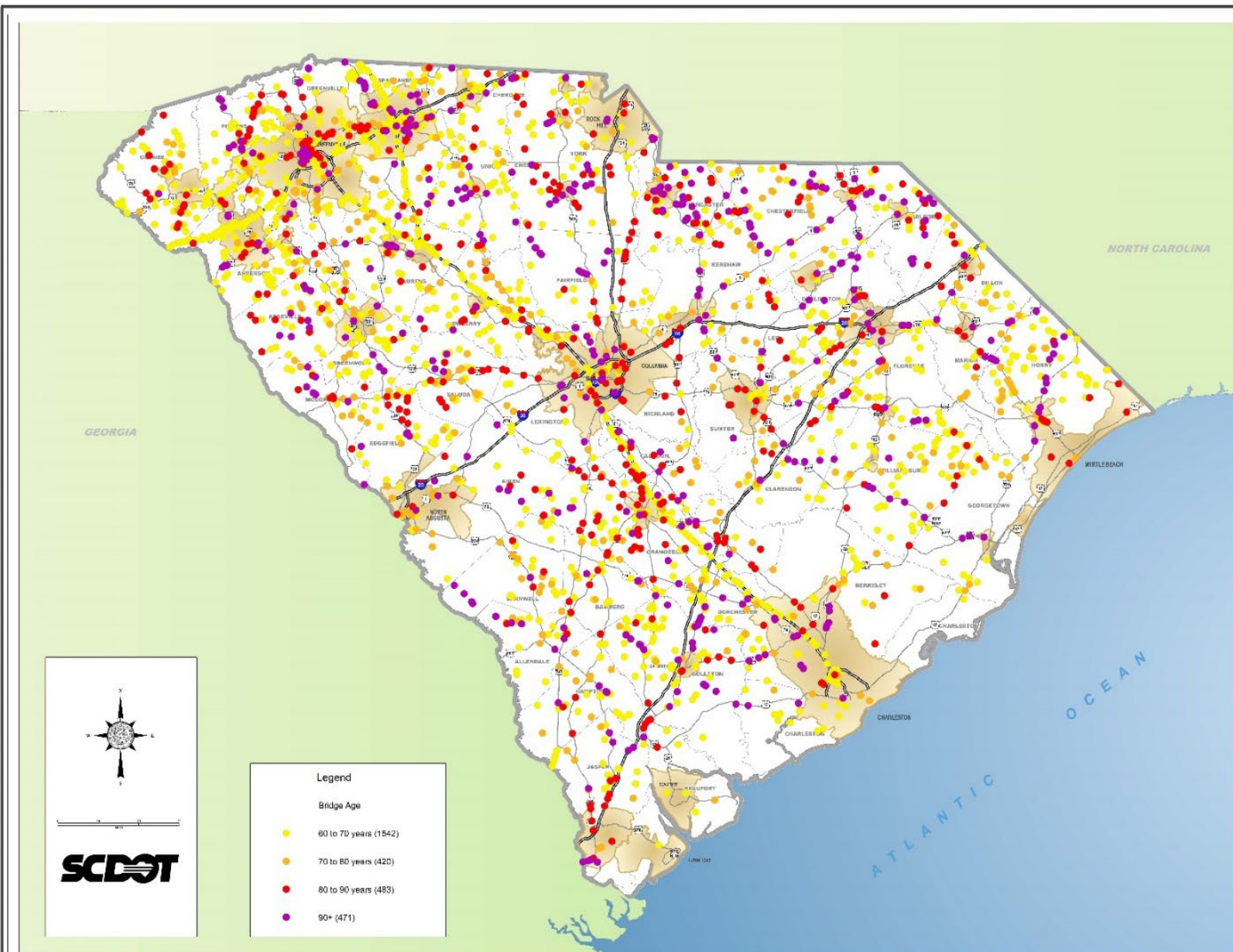
