A chronological resume format is used when the job seeker is seeking or applying for career opportunities in a current area or profession for which they are currently completing a degree or are working.

Include a Career Objective if you know exactly the position you are applying. If you are using your resume to “network” or to give to professors, nurse recruiters, or at a Job Fair, **leave the Career Objective off.**
