As the university community prepares to begin a new academic year, it is time for student “move-in “days Wednesday, August 21<sup>st</sup> through Sunday, August 25<sup>th</sup>. Peak congestion for first year student move-in is expected Friday, August 24<sup>th</sup> between 6 a.m. and 3 p.m. UNH Police, in collaboration with UNH Parking Services, will close selected parking lots on the evening of Wednesday, August 21<sup>st</sup>.

Over the years, we have developed proven strategies for managing the experience for students and their families. The process works well thanks to the outstanding cooperation from faculty and staff whose work is less directly related to move-in and accommodate this annual request for patience and flexibility. Please consider, with the approval of your supervisor, altering your arrival and departure times or, working virtually from an off-campus location especially on Friday August 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Most of the campus parking lots will be “CLOSED” for staging to support student move-in operations. If you must commute to campus on any of these days, please be aware of conditions that may impact travel and parking (and that could result in cars being towed at the owner’s expense if they are left in lots designated as “closed”). Please anticipate and be prepared for last-minute changes and additional directions from the UNH Police who will be supervising parking and traffic during move-in days. - **Wednesday, August 21<sup>st</sup>** – Gables & Woodside move-in timeslots from 0800 – 1700 hours.
- **Thursday, August 22<sup>nd</sup>** – Gables & Woodside move-in timeslots from 0800 – 1700 hours & EVEN floors of Christensen, Williamson & Stoke Halls move-in timeslots begin at 0800 – 1600hrs.
- **Friday, August 23<sup>rd</sup>** – First Year & Transfer Undergraduate Students (**ODD** floors of Christensen, Williamson, Stoke & all other residence halls) – with move-in timeslots begin at 0800hrs; end approx. 1600hrs.
- **Saturday, August 24<sup>th</sup>** – Returning Students (ALL residence halls) – with move-in timeslots begin at 0800hrs; end approx. 1600hrs.
- **Sunday, August 25<sup>th</sup>** – Gables & Woodside move-in timeslots from 0800 – 1700 hours & Late Arrivals 0900 – 1600 hrs.

The lots will be **closed for parking** will be the following:

- **For Thursday** → Lot B (Babcock side / half); Ballard Loop; Brook Way (ALL parking spots straight back to the old NEC, and the rear of Stoke Hall except for the RHD; Lot E, Lot E-1& Lot E-2; and,
- **For Friday & Saturday** → Campus Crossing Visitor Lot; Lot B (Babcock side/half); HSSC parking lot; Edgewood Visitor Lot; Quad Way – Upper/Lower Quad parking spots; Ballard Loop; HSSC Lot; Brook Way (ALL parking spots straight back to the old NEC, and the rear of Stoke Hall with the exception of the RHD spots); Lot E, Lot E-1, and Lot E-2.

Anyone having to park on-campus on Thursday, Friday and Saturday are welcome to temporarily park in:

- F-Lot (across from Morse Hall),
- N Lot (Nesmith Hall), P Lot (Parsons Hall),
- Contractor lot on Waterworks Road next to Gregg Hall,
- D Lot (Elliot Alumni Center),
- A-Lot,
- Mast Road Lot,
- Molies Lot, &
- West Edge Lot.

We apologize for any inconvenience the move-in process might cause you. We greatly appreciate your continued efforts and support to welcome our students and their families to campus in true Wildcat fashion.
