



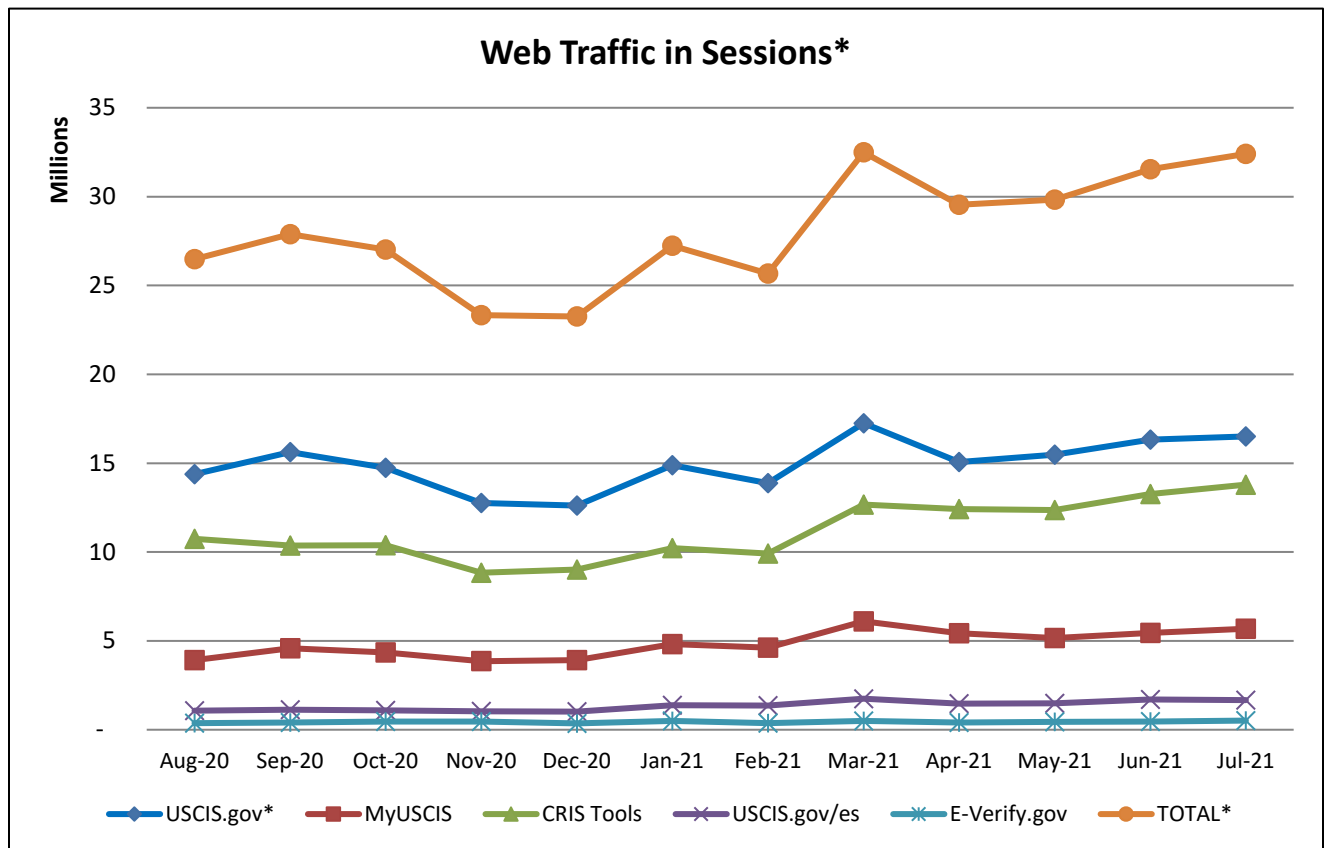

Total Web Traffic – ALL PROPERTIES: 32,407,021 sessions (+2.8% from past month)

Highlights:

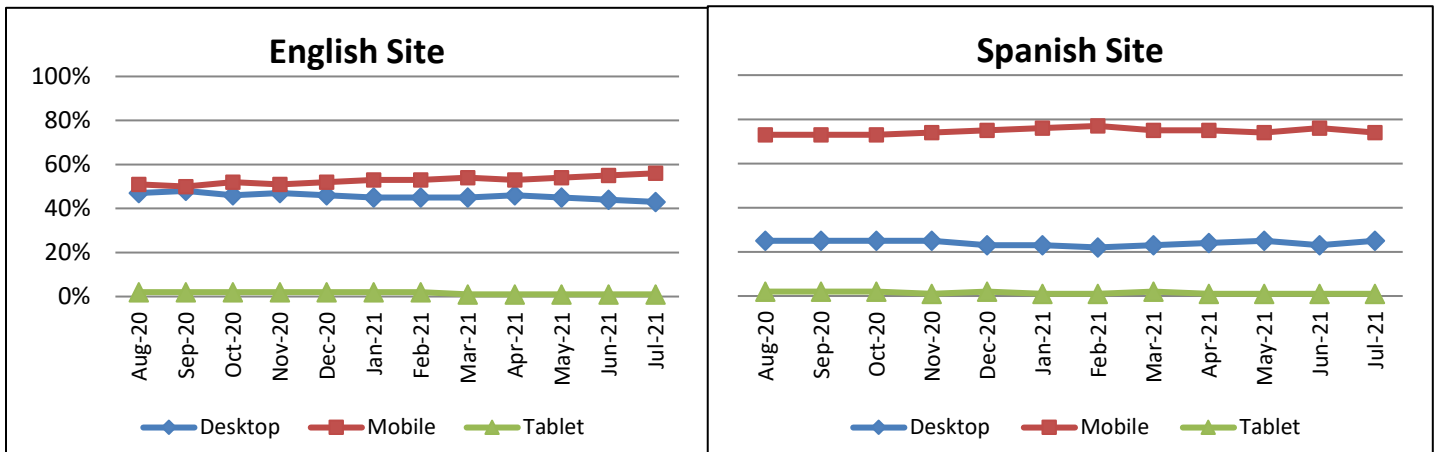
- Overall Web Traffic Remains Steady above 2020 Levels, Rising to Highest Level in Past 12 Months:** Traffic remained steady over the previous month, up nearly 3%, and web traffic remained well above the average monthly traffic from 2020. The 32.4 million sessions recorded nearly matched the previous high in March 2021.

For example, in a single session, some people visit two or even all three of the domains.
