



Highlights:


- Web Traffic: Traffic in April was down over 12% versus March, but still significantly higher at over 13.4 million than average monthly traffic in 2016.
- Spike in Interest for TPS Haiti: Since March, there has been a significant increase in interest in the issue of TPS Haiti and potential renewal of the program:
 - o For the month of April, <u>TPS Haiti page on uscis.gov</u> received 54,500 unique pageviews, up from 17,500 in March, an increase of more than 3 times in traffic.
 - o Over the same period, TPS Haiti was the #2 search term on our site behind processing times (which is the normal #1).
 - o We've also seen a big spike in views of the <u>TPS Haiti video</u> that was originally posted in 2010. For the year before March 1, it was never viewed more than 5 times/day. It hit a peak of 230 views on April 5.
- Redesigned Green Card/EAD Card Rollout #1 on Facebook: Our April 19 news alert on our redesigned Green Cards and EAD cards garnered wide attention, and provided our top post on Facebook.


USCIS.gov Website Visitors: Percentages using desktop, mobile and tablets over time
