Alabama	Anything – even 100% online programs	Yes, programs listed in the Electronic Campus are exempt
Arizona	Anything – even 100% online programs	Yes, programs listed in the Electronic Campus are exempt
Delaware	Internships, externships, field experiences, proctored exams or tests established by either the student or the institution	Yes, programs listed in the Electronic Campus are exempt
Washington, DC	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums – with a possible exception if “the local offering is for the institutions own students, regularly enrolled on its home campus and the instruction does not fulfill more than 25% of the normal degree requirements.”	No
Iowa	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums. However, two points of clarification: For distance education if the face-to face experience is necessary for program completion and it is structured (e.g., there is a paid or unpaid preceptor, facilitator, or other supervisor at the Iowa site that provides feedback to the school. For residential programs, the face-to-face experience is not a physical presence trigger provided that the school compensates no one at the Iowa location to provide instruction or supervision	No
Kansas	All programs are required to be authorized, regardless of physical presence.	No
Kentucky	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums, direct and targeted recruiting of students for distance education programs	No
Louisiana	Any face to face, including physical instruction or experiences that result in contact with others and awarding of credit (internships, student teaching, clinicals).	In process
Maryland	Practicums, internships, or other instructional experience regardless of whether credit is awarded for the experience	Yes, programs listed in the Electronic Campus are exempt
Massachusetts	Internships, externships, clinical residences, mentorships, shadowing experiences, student teaching experiences	No
Minnesota	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums	No

Montana	All online programs must be authorized regardless of physical presence	No
Nevada	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums	No
New Hampshire	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums organized by the institution. Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums found by the student acting independently are NOT a physical presence.	No
New Mexico	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums	No
North Carolina	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums	Yes, but even programs listed in the Electronic Campus that have a physical presence must be approved. Only programs that are 100% online are authorized.
Ohio	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums	No
Oregon	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums, student teaching	No
Pennsylvania	Pennsylvania generally does not provide jurisdiction over Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums but we are not yet authorized for distance education programs.	No
Texas	Clinicals, internships, or other field-based learning experiences for both online and traditional on-ground programs.	Yes, programs listed in the Electronic Campus are exempt
Washington	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums – only applies to distance education students. Traditional on-ground programs that have field based experiences are exempt.	No
West Virginia	Internships, externships, field experiences, clinical practicums	Yes, programs listed in the Electronic Campus are exempt
