CARIBE WAVE 22 Summary

- CARIBE WAVE 22 was held on March 10, 2022. Over 406,000 people registered and participated in the Trunk and Branch Zone activities.
- PTWC and the Dismal Message and Implementation Trunk and Branch (TWFP and NTWC).
- The Sea Level Data Monitoring and Reporting System. According to an analysis by ITIC-CAR, 32 of the 52 regional activities listed in the PTWC Implementation Plan were operational.
- Social media platforms were a primary mode of communication for participants, each reaching over 1.2 million people worldwide.


