

March 19-20, 2012 Severe Storms Event

A severe storm and minor flood event occurred from late afternoon on March 19 through mid-morning on March 20, 2012. There were three confirmed tornadoes just to the southwest of metro San Antonio, over two dozen hail reports (including up to baseball-size), and widespread rainfall of 2 to 5 inches along and east of U.S. Highway 281. Minor to moderate river flooding occurred at locations along and east of the Interstate 35 corridor, and numerous low water crossings and other flood prone urban locations were under water through early afternoon on the 20th.

The primary ingredients producing the event included a deep upper level trough (i.e., stretching from the Canadian border into northern Mexico), cold front with a Pacific-origin airmass behind it (i.e., slightly cooler, but much drier air), and moist Gulf air (dew points in the 60s) in place across South Central Texas ahead of the upper level trough and cold front, which moved slowly from west to east across Texas. Thunderstorms first developed along the front in Val Verde County, and quickly became severe, with the first severe thunderstorm warning being issued at 2:30 pm CDT. These storms in the west eventually congealed into a line of storms along the eastward-moving front, while additional supercell storms developed just west of Interstate 35 and to the southwest of metro San Antonio.

One of the supercells produced three tornadoes (details in a table below) between 8:06 and 8:30 pm, with initial estimates of a dozen people injured, 22 homes destroyed, 16 with major damage, and 9 with minor damage. Most of the homes destroyed or with major damage were mobile homes. There was one fatality; a woman in her car was swept of the road by West Yegua Creek near Fedor. A Mesoscale Convective System (MCS) comprised of storms that had developed earlier over the west, then slowly moved across the area, bringing heavy rain, gusty winds, and pea to dime-size hail. Some of the larger rainfall amounts included 4.83 inches 5 miles north-northwest of Burnet, 4.78 inches 3 1/2 miles northwest of Marble Falls, and 4.02 inches at Tow.

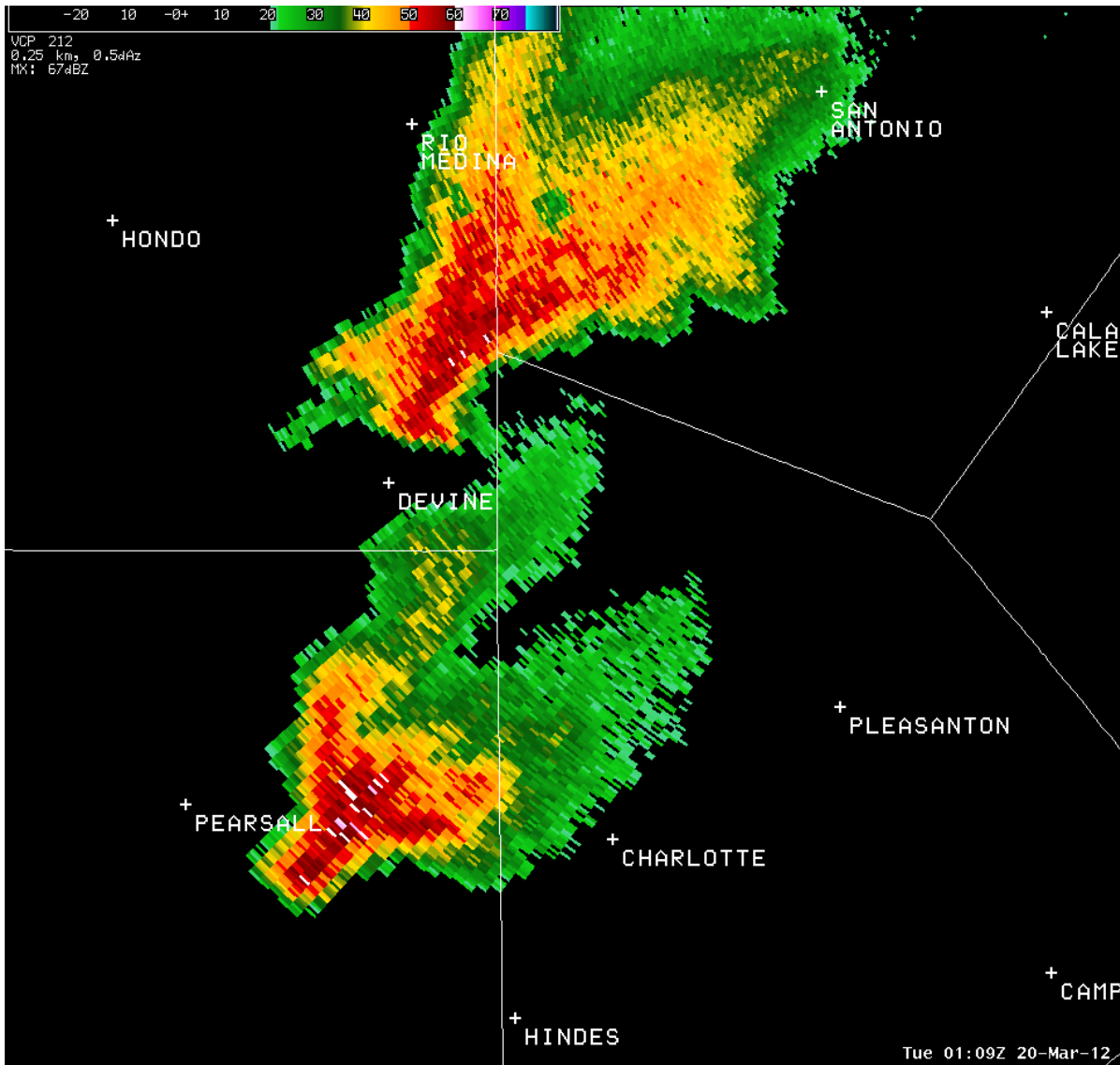


Figure 1. Radar Base Reflectivity, 0.25 km resolution, at 8:09 pm CDT March 19, 2012, near the time of the first tornado touchdown near Devine, TX.

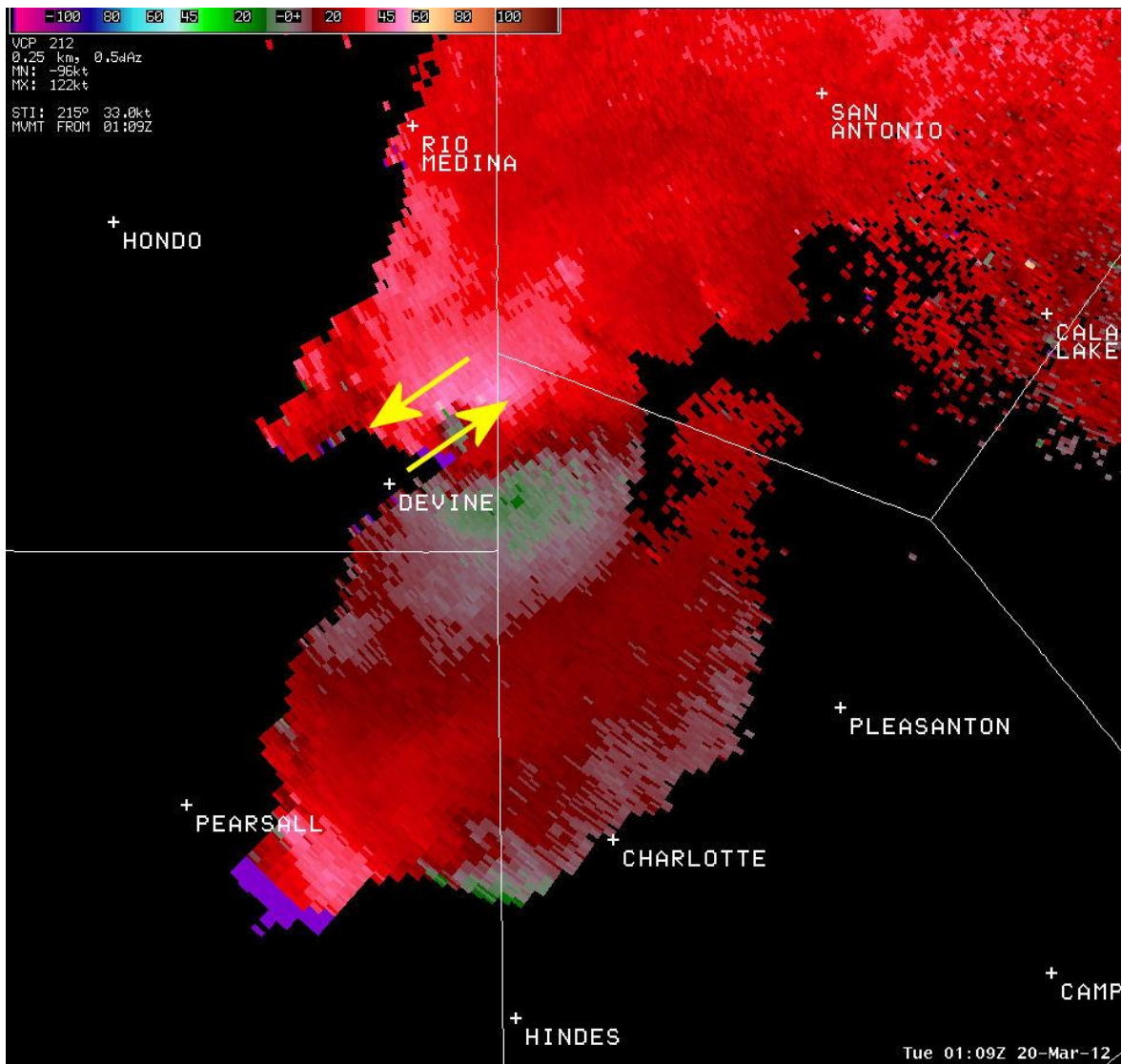


Figure 2. Radar Storm-Relative Velocity, 0.25 km resolution, at 8:09 pm CDT March 19, 2012, near the time of the first tornado touchdown near Devine, TX. Yellow arrows show the mesocyclone rotation, the tornado being located in-between the arrows.

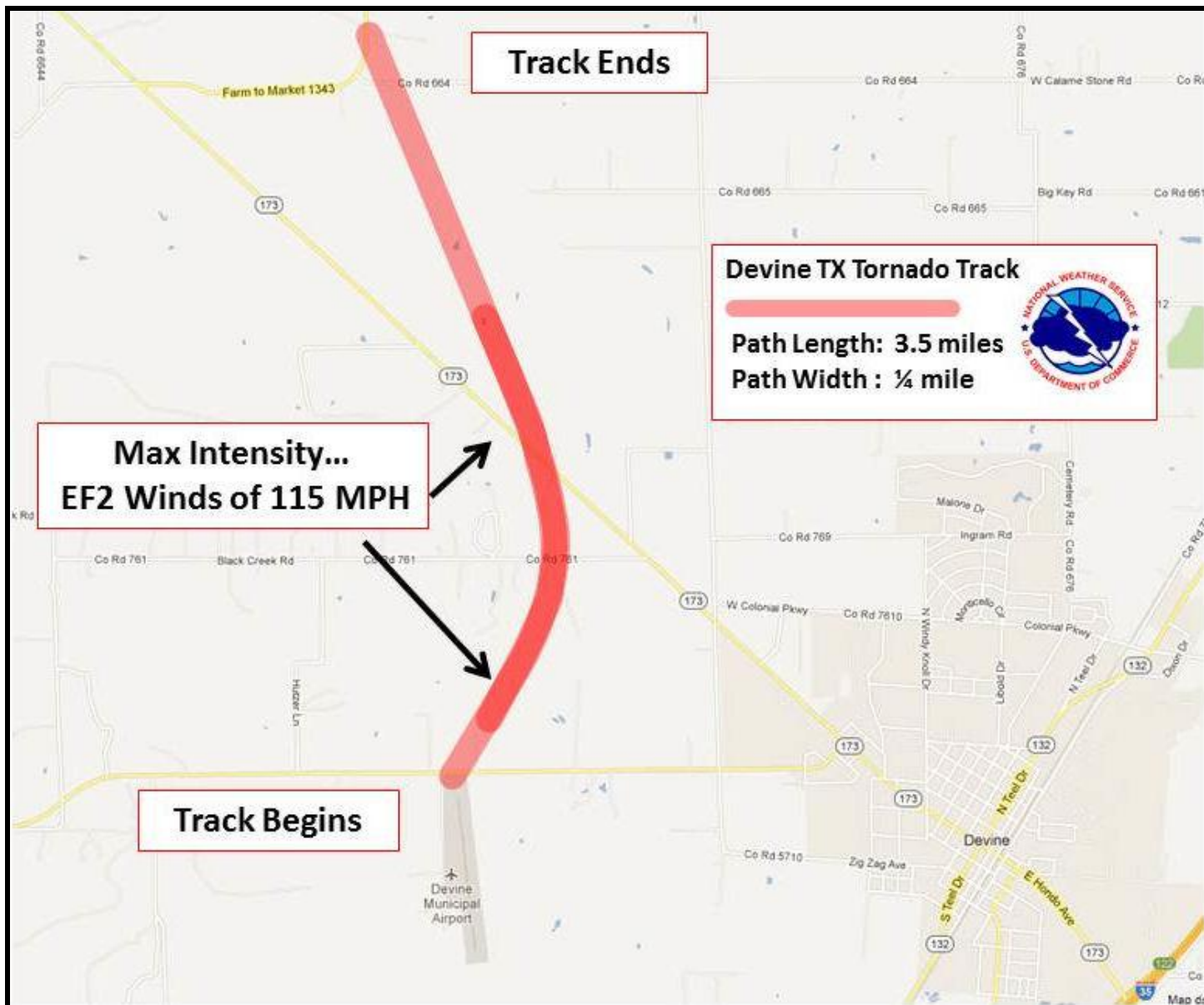


Figure 3. Storm survey track for the Devine, TX, EF2 Tornado on March 19, 2012.

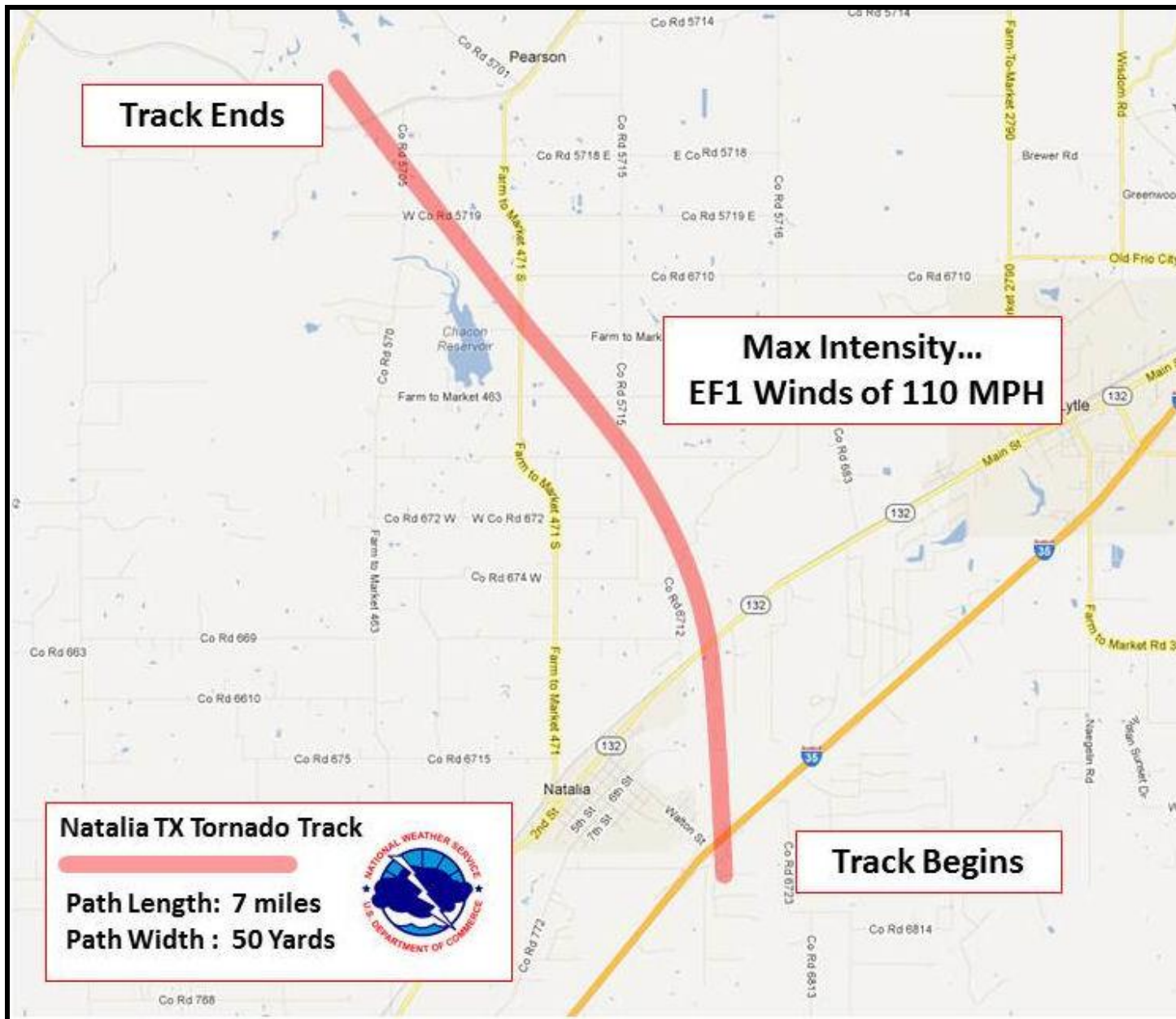


Figure 6. Storm survey track for the Natalia, TX, EF1 Tornado on March 19, 2012.

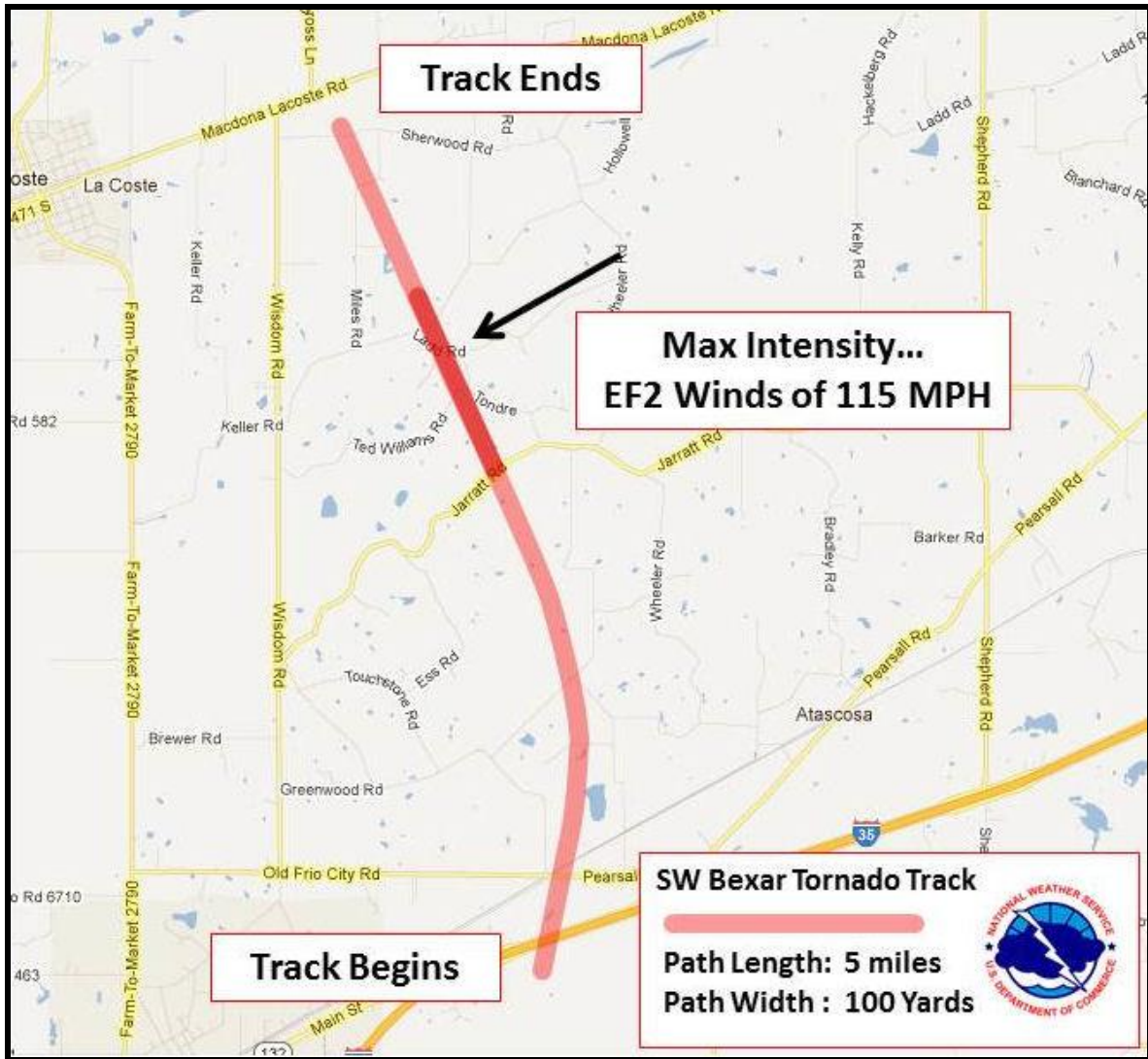


Figure 7. Storm survey track for the southwestern Bexar County, TX, EF2 Tornado on March 19, 2012.

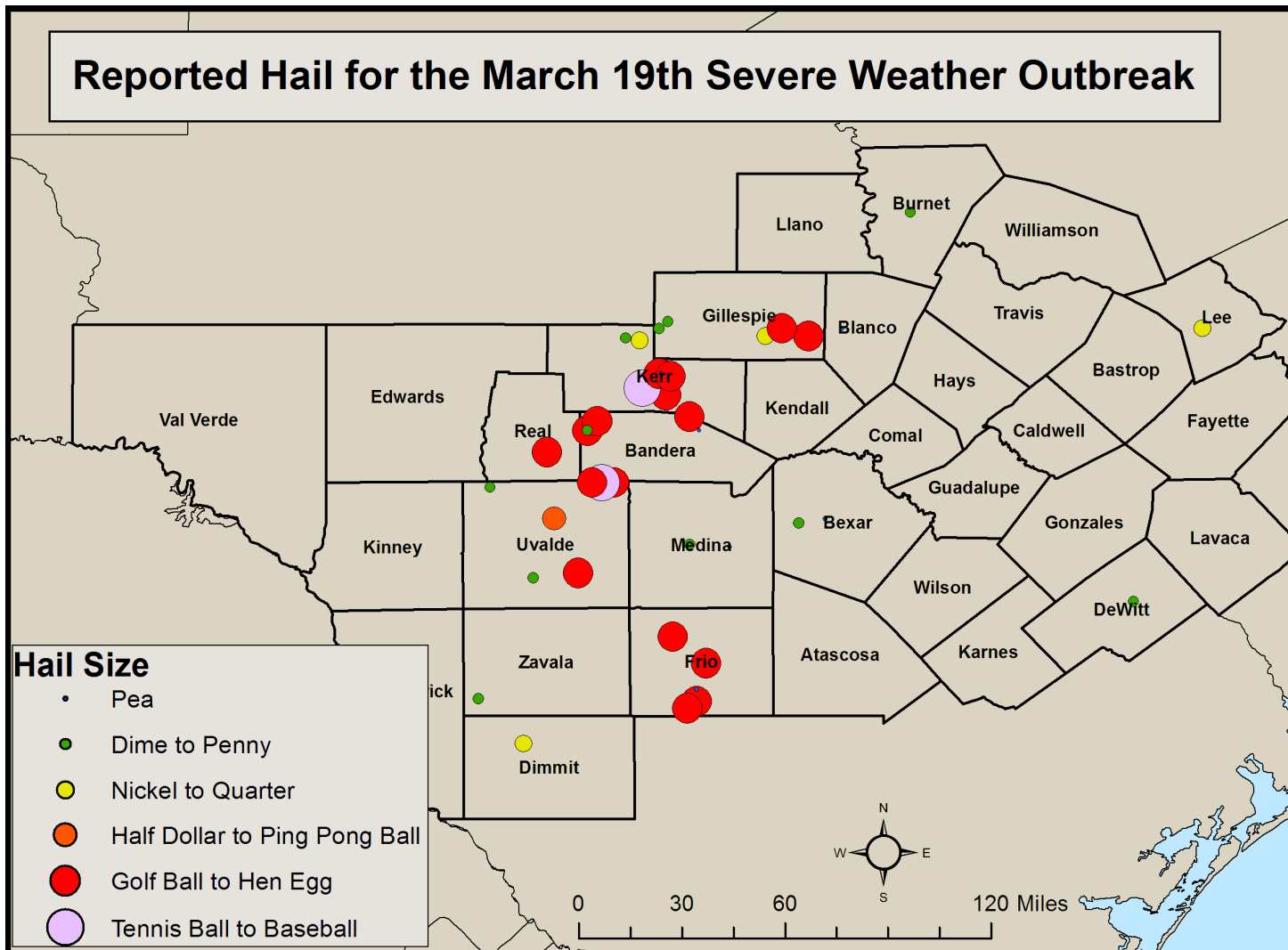


Figure 9. Preliminary hail reports from March 19, 2012.

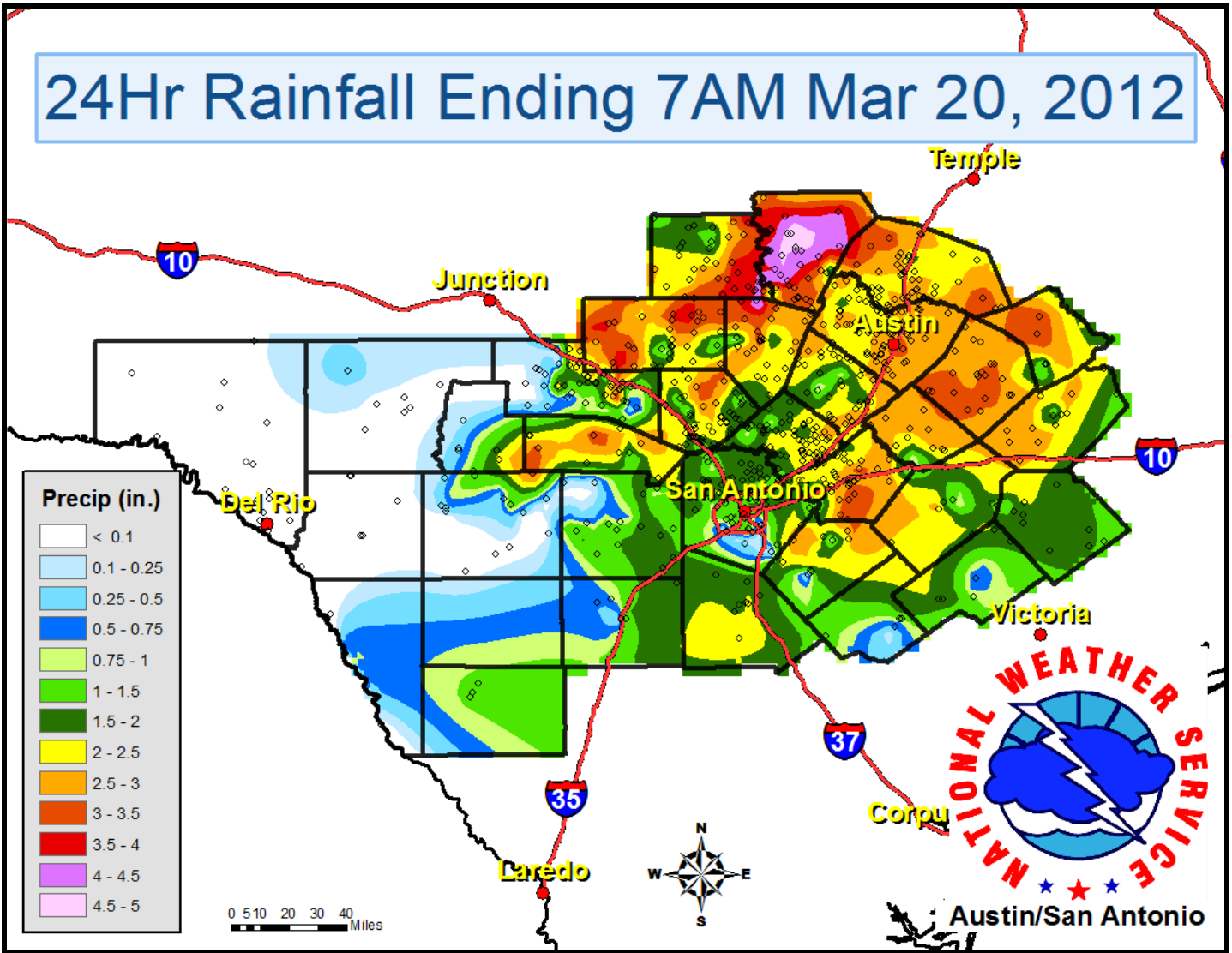


Figure 10. Preliminary 24-hour rainfall map from Cooperative, CoCoRaHS and other agency raingauge network observations.

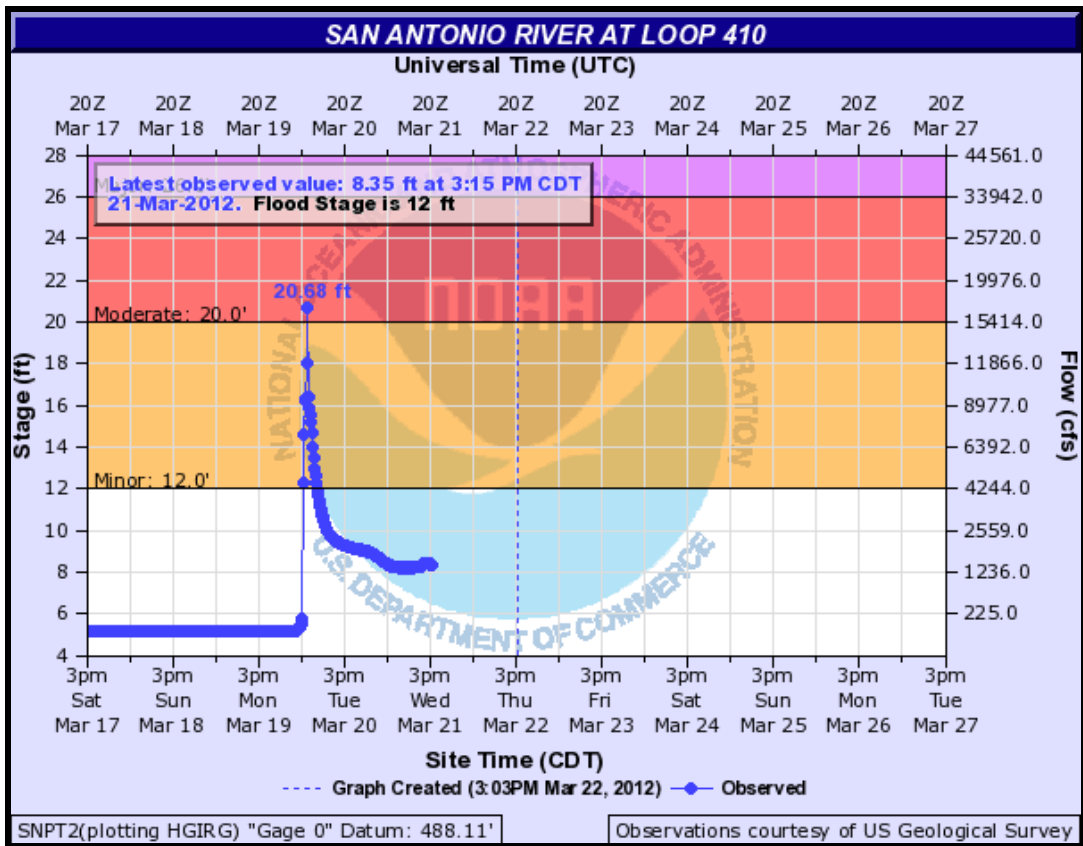


Figure 11. Hydrograph of the river gauge on the San Antonio River at Interstate Loop 410.

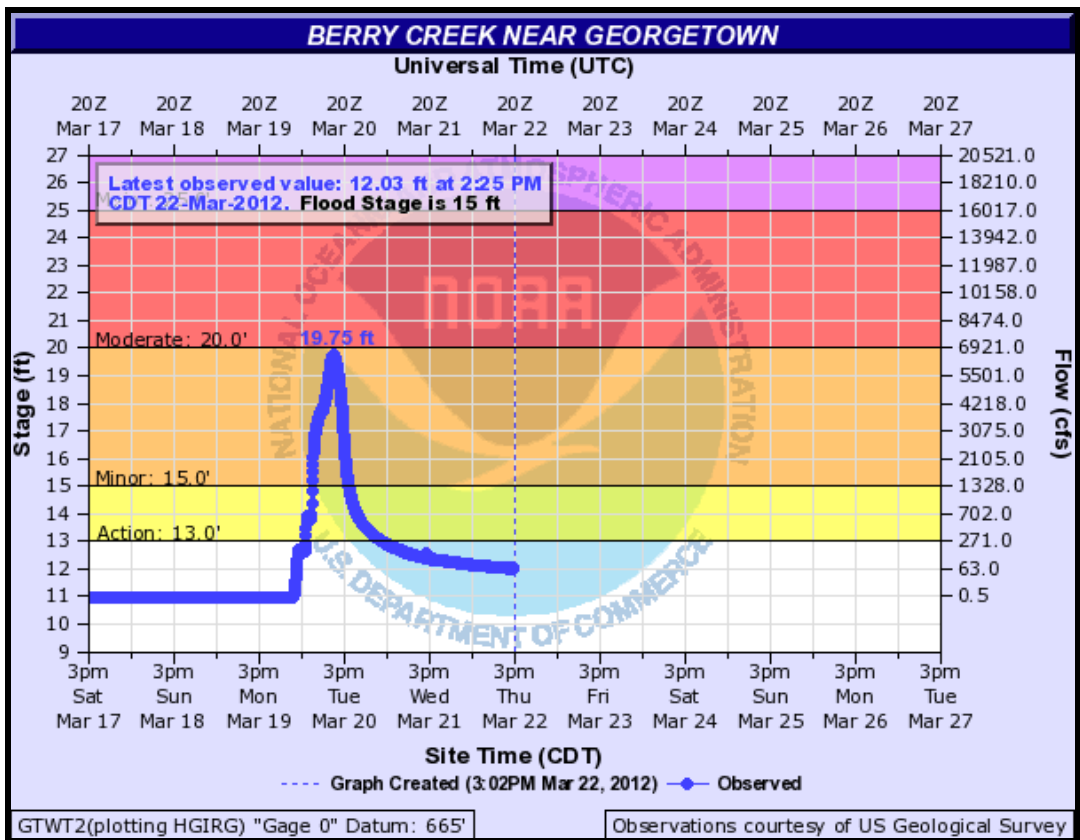


Figure 12. Hydrograph of the river gauge on Berry Creek near Georgetown.
