- Another warm and mostly dry month to end across the region.
- Terrell County hit the jackpot for rain when the remnants of Tropical Storm Harold moved through on Aug. 22nd and 23rd accumulating 5.50" of rain over two days in Dryden.
- KMAF saw another streak of 100°F days from Aug 3rd through 13th. This is tied for 7th all time.
- KMAF also only recorded a trace of rain on the 23rd and 28th. The summer (Jun-Aug) total stands at just 0.39". Less than 2011 which had just 0.45".

- Warmest Day: 107°F on the 7th, 9th, 10th
- Coldest Night: 66°F on the 29th, 31st
- Average Temperature: 87.5°F (Normal: 81.3°F)
- Precipitation Total: T (Normal: 1.64")

- Highest Wind Gust: 43 mph on the 23rd
