

Regional Climate Summary

February 2024

Weather Forecast Office
Midland/Odessa, TX

Issued March 17, 2024 9:18 AM CT



- Much of the area was well above normal with many spots seeing a top 10 warmest February on record.
- Precipitation was near normal for West Texas with the Davis Mountains and Marfa Plateau seeing above normal precipitation.
- Despite the warmth, snow fell across southeast New Mexico and the Permian Basin on the 11th with only a trace recorded at MAF and around an inch seen in spots across Eddy County, NM.
- Much of the precipitation seen for the whole month fell on Leap Day where KMAF set a new daily rainfall record of 0.29".

- Coldest Night: 24°F on the 18th
- Average Temperature: 53.5°F (Normal: 50.2°F)
- Precipitation Total: 0.38" (Normal: 0.58")
