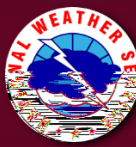


Regional Climate Summary

November 2023

Weather Forecast Office
Midland/Odessa, TX



Issued December 11, 2023 1:24 PM CT

- Despite a warm stretch at the beginning of the month, average temperatures across the region fell within a degree or two of normal.
- The Big Bend, Davis Mountains, and Lower Trans Pecos hit the jackpot with well above precipitation for the month. Below average precipitation was seen across SE New Mexico and the Permian Basin.
- KMAF was below freezing just once during November on the morning of the first.
- High winds were seen across the Guadalupe Mountains and portions of SE New Mexico on the 19th and 30th. Highest recorded gusts at Guadalupe Pass was 67mph.

- Coldest Night: 31°F on the 1st
- Average Temperature: 54.7°F (Normal: 54.3°F)
- Precipitation Total: 0.64" (Normal: 0.72")

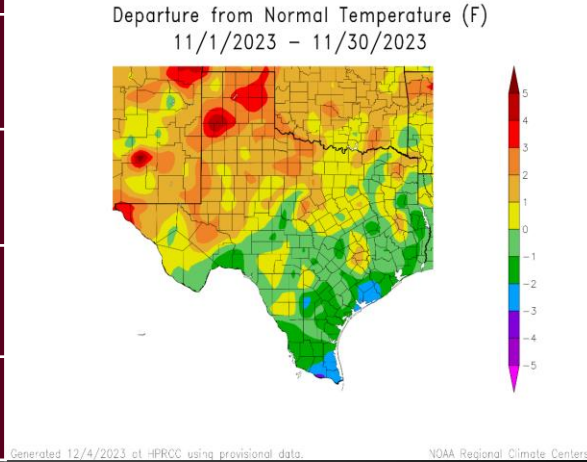
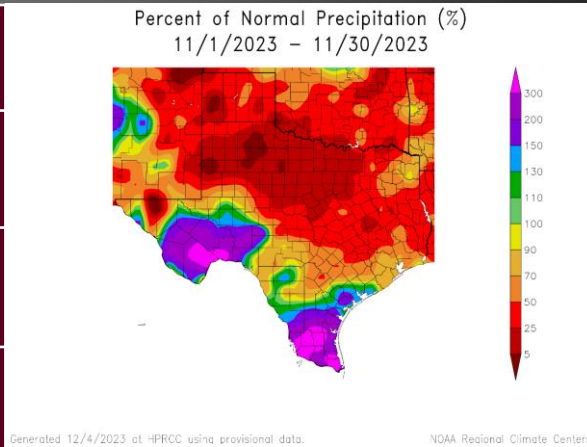

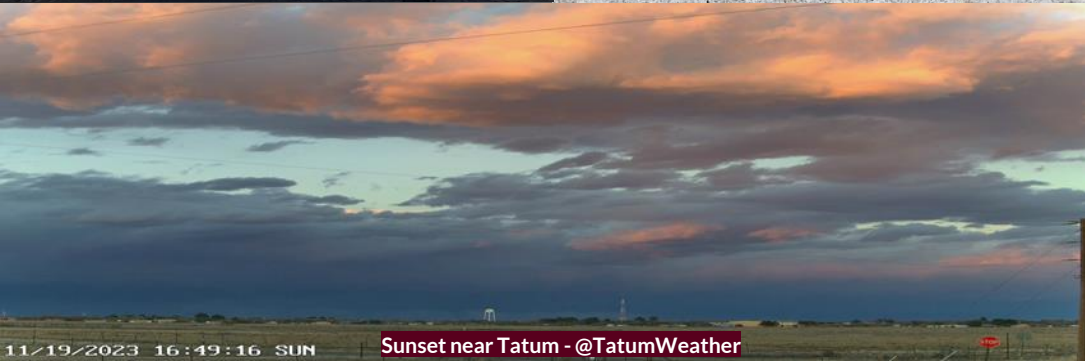
