Subject: Modifying Application Programming Interface Response Headers on  
February 7, 2022

On February 7, 2022, beginning at 1330 Coordinated Universal Time (UTC),  
the Application Programming Interface (api.weather.gov) was modified to  
eliminate the "Last-Modified" header in responses to requests from the  
following Uniform Resource Locators (URLs):

<https://api.weather.gov/gridpoints/<wfo>/<x,y>>  
<https://api.weather.gov/gridpoints/<wfo>/<x,y>/forecast>  
<https://api.weather.gov/gridpoints/<wfo>/<x,y>/forecast/hourly>

Where <wfo> is a valid Weather Forecast Office three-letter string and  
<x,y> are x and y gridpoints. For example, for WFO Baltimore/Washington  
in Sterling, VA:

<https://api.weather.gov/gridpoints/LWX/82,75>  
<https://api.weather.gov/gridpoints/LWX/82,75/forecast>  
<https://api.weather.gov/gridpoints/LWX/82,75/forecast/hourly>

This header change is temporary and will be added back in a future  
release of the application.
