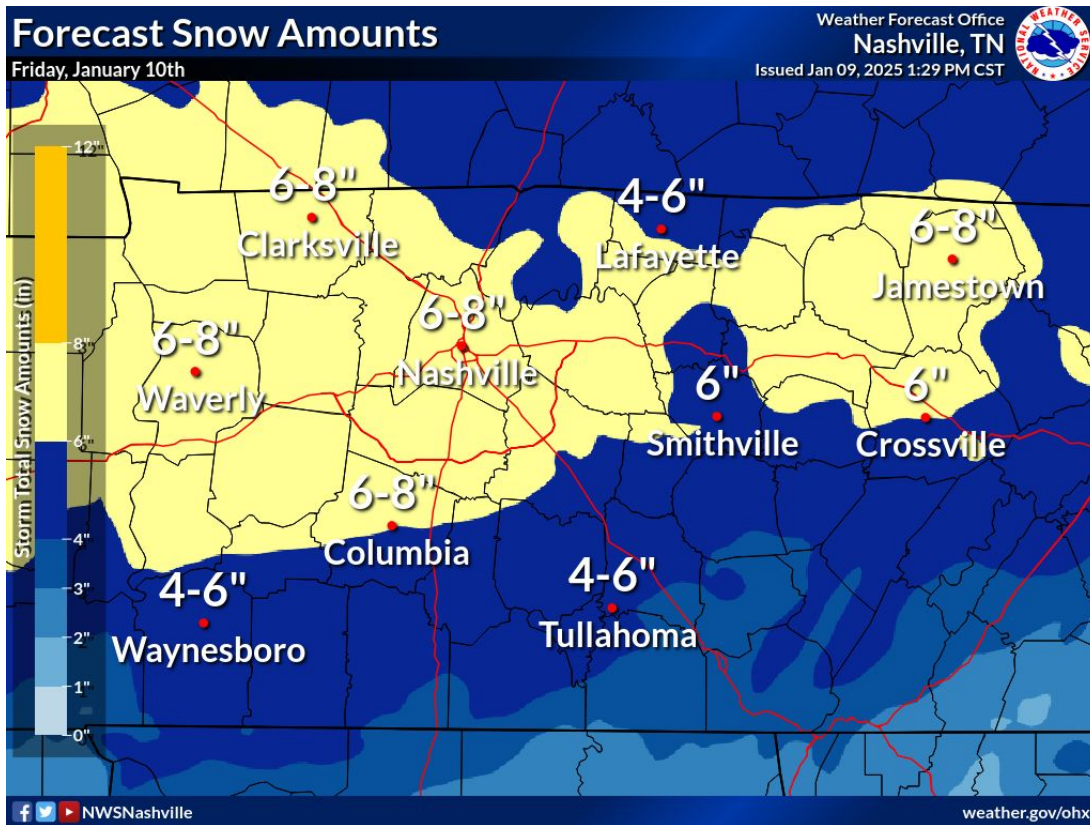




Winter Storm Warning for Snow



Winter Storm Warning Details

- Beginning Friday 3 AM - Saturday 6 AM for areas west of the Plateau
- Beginning Friday 9 AM - Saturday 6 AM for the Plateau

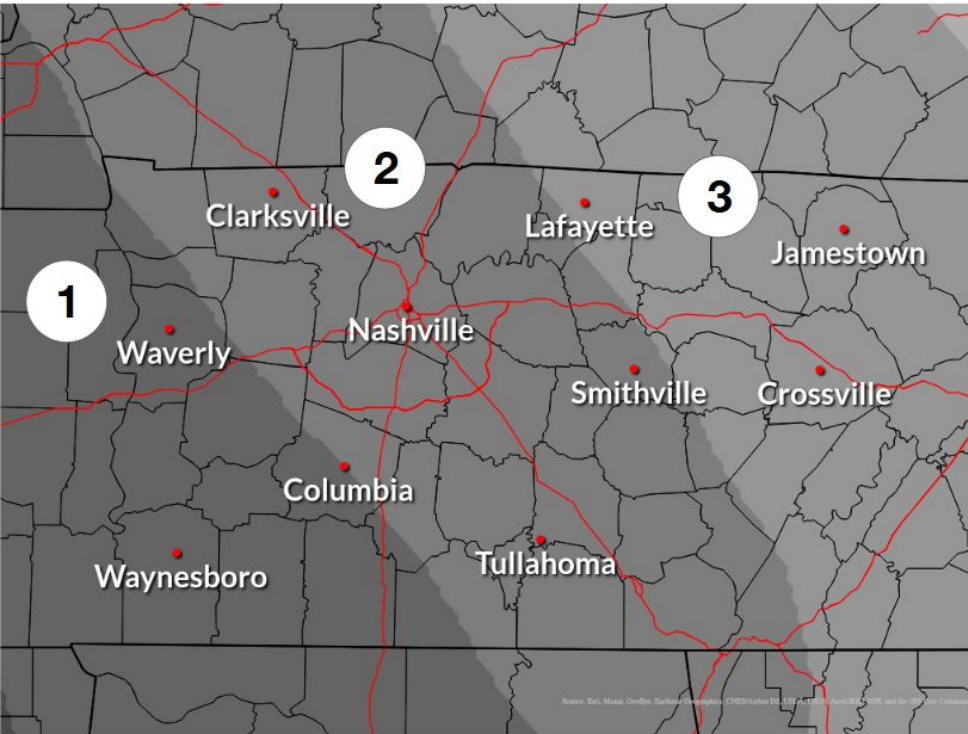
Forecast Details

- Travel impacts from snow starting early Friday morning
- 4 to 7 inches will be common with localized 8 to 9 inch amounts
- Most of the snow will fall mid morning through evening
- Little or no sleet or freezing rain
- Snow tapering off Friday evening, but significant travel impacts will continue into Saturday
- Continued cold weather will result in slow melting. Partial thawing and refreezing could keep travel conditions hazardous for several days, especially in rural areas, secondary roads, sidewalks, and parking lots

Forecaster Comments:

- **Worst case scenario: 6-8 inches west of the Plateau, 8-10 inches along the Plateau**
- Some models show warmer air coming up from the south causing a wintry mix across the southern counties. We believe this will be brief. The main result will be slightly lower snow totals near the Alabama border, but travel impacts will still occur
- 3 to 6 inches will be common, but some enhanced narrow bands may result in 7 or 8 inches in a few spots
- Snow will end from west to east, clearing middle TN at the latest by 3 AM
- Peak melting days will be Sunday and Monday when afternoon temperatures warm into the upper 30s
