






JULY: Wettest July on Record at BWI Wettest July in Washington in Nearly 30 Years



Monthly Highlights

- ♦ Slightly below normal temperatures in Washington and Baltimore and slightly above normal temperatures at IAD
- ♦ At or below normal temperatures at DCA on 18 days
- ♦ Only 4 days with highs at or above 90°F at DCA (fewest since 2000) and BWI and two at IAD with monthly extreme maximum temperatures of only 92°F at DCA & BWI and 91°F at IAD
- ♦ Lows of 70°F+ at DCA on 23 days
- ♦ Wettest July since 1975 in Washington
- ♦ Wettest July 4th (2.18") ever recorded in Washington
- ♦ Numerous flash flood producing thunderstorms deluge region, flooding roads, overflowing steams and creeks and leading to water rescues including the 4th, 7th, 12th, and 27th, resulting in monthly totals over a foot in some areas.
- Second consecutive year with a cooler than normal June and July, the first such occurrence since June-July 1962 and 1963
- July 2003 and 2004 were the wettest back-to-back Julys since 1969 and 1970
