







PREcipitation Summary and Temperature Observations For the Washington, DC & Baltimore, MD Area

MARCH: Driest March in Washington/ Baltimore Area Since 1987





Monthly Highlights

- Above normal temperatures with subnormal precipitation across the area
- ♦ DCA recorded 15 days with highs at or above normal
- ♦ Highs at or above 70°F on 6 days at DCA & IAD; 4 days at BWI
- ◆ Lows at or below freezing on 15 days at IAD, 13 at BWI, and 5 at DCA
- Sudden severe thunderstorms swept across Maryland on afternoon of 6th with wind gusts to 60 mph, capsizing a shuttle boat in Baltimore's Inner Harbor which led to four fatalities and numerous injuries, according to press reports
- Driest March since 1987 at DCA and since 1995 at BWI & IAD
- More than an inch of rain at some locations on the 6th (1.31" at BWI) and close to an inch of precipitation across the remainder of the local area
- No measurable snowfall reported across region
- Sixth driest January-March recorded in Washington (see graph above)
