

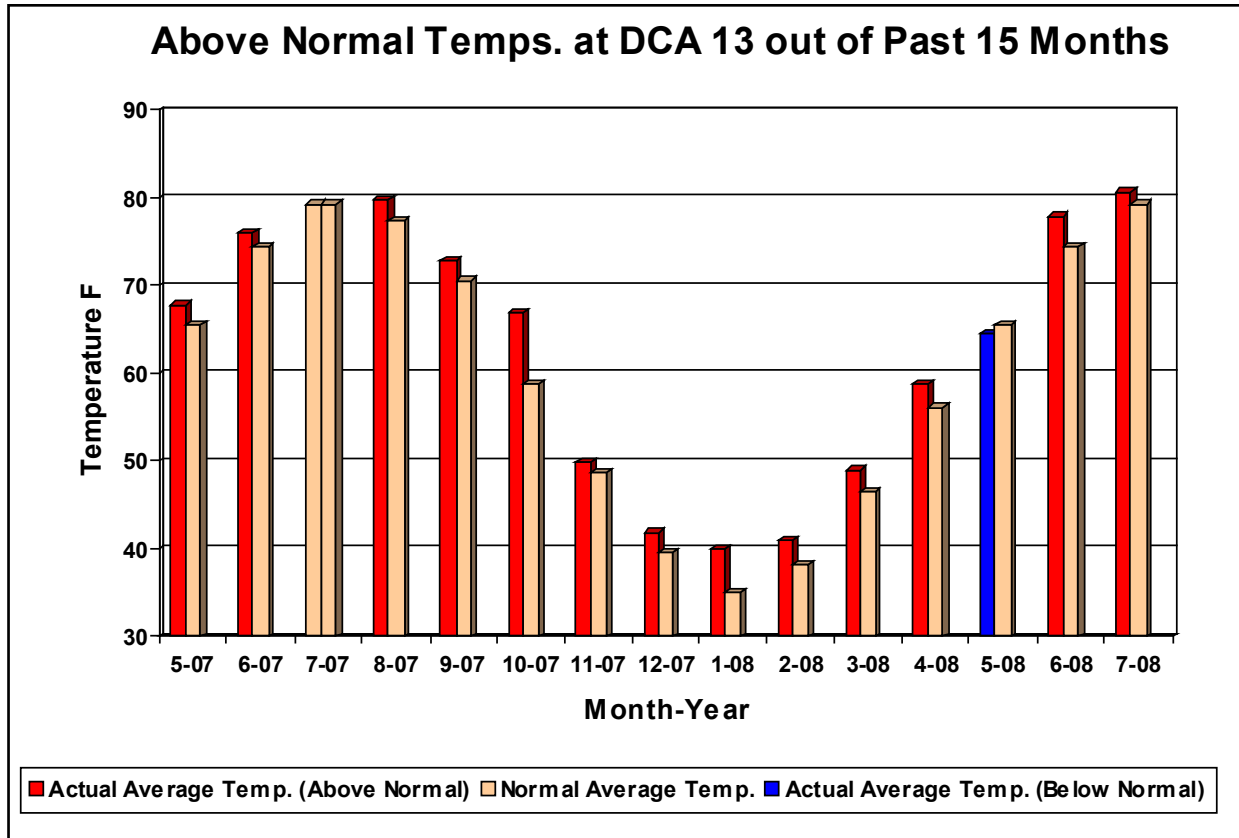


# PRESTO



PRECipitation Summary and Temperature Observations  
For the Washington, DC & Baltimore, MD Area

## JULY: Above Normal Temperature Trend Continues; Numerous Severe Weather Events



### July Highlights

- ✦ Above normal temperatures across the area: +1.5 at DCA, +1.0 at BWI, and +1.1 at IAD
- ✦ Highs at or above 90°F on 14 days at DCA; 11 at IAD, 10 at BWI
- ✦ Six days with highs at or above 95°F at DCA so far this year
- ✦ Minimum at or above 70°F at DCA on 23 days
- ✦ Numerous days with severe weather including 23<sup>rd</sup> with tornadoes reports in Rappahannock County (EF-0: winds estimated at 80 mph) and in Prince William County (EF-0: winds estimated at 75 mph); some property damage. Over 20,000 customers lose power according to press reports; 2.42" rainfall measured at BWI and 1.09" at DCA;
- ✦ DCA records wind gust to 51 mph on 22<sup>nd</sup>; golf ball size hail was observed in Baltimore County, MD
- ✦ Hail pelts close to BWI on 27<sup>th</sup>, four injuries reported; three the result of thunderstorm wind damage in Fairfax County, VA, and one the result of lightning in Montgomery County, MD., according to press reports.
