






PREcipitation Summary and Temperature Observations For the Washington, DC & Baltimore, MD Area

JULY: Above Normal Temperature Trend Continues; Numerous Severe Weather Events



July Highlights

- Above normal temperatures across the area: +1.5 at DCA, +1.0 at BWI, and +1.1 at IAD
- Highs at or above 90°F on 14 days at DCA; 11 at IAD, 10 at BWI
- Six days with highs at or above 95°F at DCA so far this year
- Minimum at or above 70°F at DCA on 23 days
- Numerous days with severe weather including 23rd with tornadoes reports in Rappahannock County (EF-O: winds estimated at 80 mph) and in Prince William County (EF-O: winds estimated at 75 mph); some property damage. Over 20,000 customers lose power according to press reports; 2.42" rainfall measured at BWI and 1.09" at DCA;
- DCA records wind gust to 51 mph on 22nd; golf ball size hail was observed in Baltimore County, MD
- Hail pelts close to BWI on 27th, four injuries reported; three the result of thunderstorm wind damage in Fairfax County, VA, and one the result of lightning in Montgomery County, MD., according to press reports.
