NOVEMBER 1988 TEMPERATURES: Since 1973, November temperatures at DCA have averaged ABOVE NORMAL in 12 of the last 16 years, and 1988 was no exception (see table below). Similarily, temperatures at IAD and BWI have been above normal in 11 of the past 16 Novembers.

<u>AUTUMN (SEP-NOV) 1988</u>: By the end of October, it appeared as though this Fall would be one of the coldest and driest on record in the Washington, D.C. area. September and October precipitation <u>deficits</u> at DCA, BWI, and IAD totaled 2.52", 2.93", and 2.87", while the two month temperature departures from normal were -3.6°F, -3.9°F, and -3.6°F, respectively. During November, however, excess rainfall and unseasonably mild weather brought this Fall's statistics to more normal levels (see table below) and pushed DCA's 1988 precipitation over 30".
