



1972 vs. 1989 - A WET YEAR COMPARISON AT DCA

THE 51.97" IN 1972 MADE IT THE WETTEST YEAR AT DCA SINCE 1948 (57.54"). WITH 45.85" ALREADY OBSERVED IN 1989, AN ADDITIONAL 6.13" DURING NOV.-DEC. WILL SURPASS THE 1972 TOTAL.
