FEBRUARY 1990: The mild weather which began in January continued well into February. Only a brief cold snap during Feb. 25–27 prevented this February from being the warmest ever in Washington (February 1976: 46.9°F). Meanwhile, IAD and BWI recorded the first and second warmest February on record, respectively, which came on the heels of the warmest January ever at both locations (fifth warmest January at DCA). As a result, National has observed its second warmest start to a year (AvgT=44.4°F) with only Jan–Feb. 1932 being greater at 44.9°F. BWI also recorded its second warmest start to a year, while IAD reported its warmest annual commencement since records began in 1963.
