








PRECIPITATION SUMMARY AND TEMPERATURE OBSERVATIONS FOR THE WASHINGTON, DC & BALTIMORE, MD AREA

APRIL 1993

WETTEST JANUARY-APRIL PERIOD ON RECORD AT IAD AND WETTEST SINCE 1983 AT BOTH DCA AND BWI







APRIL HIGHLIGHTS

- Third consecutive cooler than normal month and second consecutive wetter than normal month at all five airports;
- Only 8 days (27%) with above normal daily temperatures at DCA;
- Second lates t "first" 70°F reading (79°F on the 15th) in Washington;
- Wettest April in ten years and third wettest on record at IAD;
- Confirmed tornadoes in Loudoun, Fauquier, and Warren counties, VA;
- Late—season frost across much of the northern and western suburbs and freeze in the Shenandoah Valley on the 28th;
- Coolest January—April period since 1988 at both DCA and lAD, and 1984 at BWI:
- 18 cloudy days (60%) at DCA during April and 75 (63%) for 1993.
