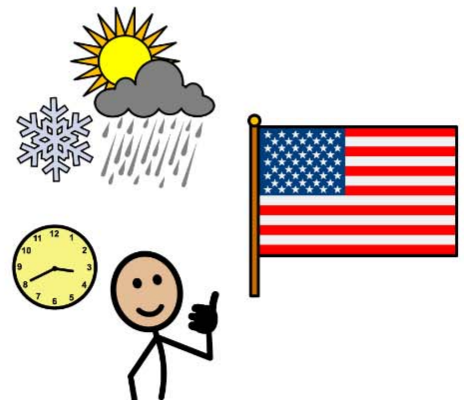


# WEATHER-READY NATION

A program helps people prepare for weather. This program is Weather-Ready Nation.

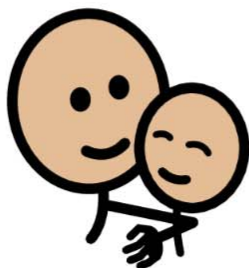
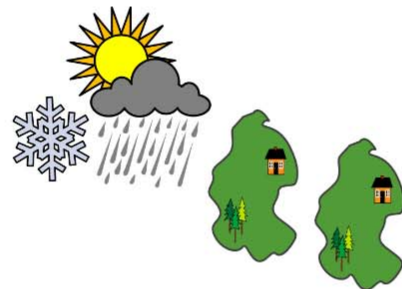

**People learn how to be safe in dangerous weather.**

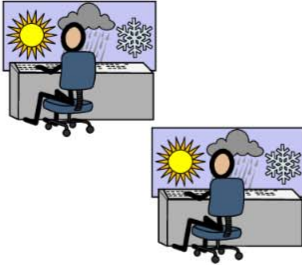


**The National Weather Service leads Weather-Ready Nation.**

**Many meteorologists work for the National Weather Service. Meteorologists are scientists. They study weather.**

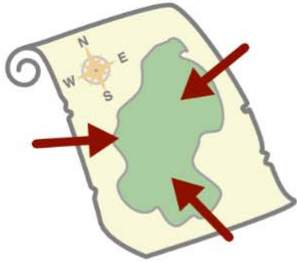


**Some meteorologists work at weather offices. These weather offices are across the U.S.**

**Meteorologists work with communities near the offices. They teach people how to be safe.**

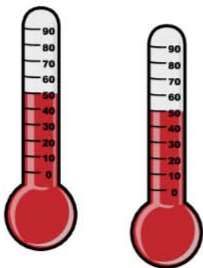


**The meteorologists look for dangerous weather.**

**A watch means people have time to prepare. Dangerous weather may be coming.**

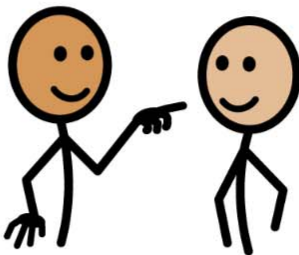


**A warning means go quickly to a safe place. Dangerous weather is coming!**

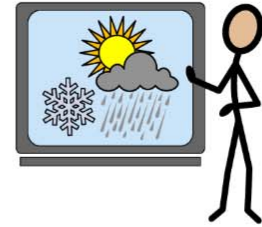

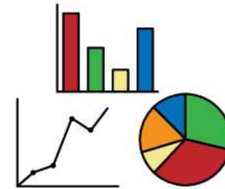


## METEOROLOGIST

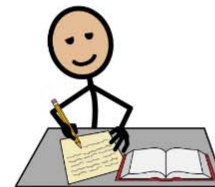


A meteorologist is a scientist who studies weather.
